

Receiving the Kingdom Within

2 Corinthians 6:16-18

16 And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? **for ye are the temple of the living God;** as God hath said, **I will dwell in them, and walk in them;** and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

17 **Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you,**

18 **And will be a Father unto you,** and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty.

Exodus 33:7-11

7 And **Moses took the tabernacle, and pitched it without the camp, afar off from the camp,** and **called it the Tabernacle of the congregation** (Tent of Meeting). And it came to pass, that everyone which sought the LORD went out unto the tabernacle of the congregation, which was without the camp.

8 And it came to pass, when Moses went out unto the tabernacle, that all the people rose up, and stood every man at his tent door, and looked after Moses, until he was gone into the tabernacle.

9 And it came to pass, as **Moses entered into the tabernacle, the cloudy pillar descended** (The Lord is the Cloudy Pillar - Exodus 34:5), **and stood at the door of the tabernacle, and the LORD talked with Moses.**

10 And all the people saw the cloudy pillar stand at the tabernacle door: and all the people rose up and worshipped, every man in his tent door.

11 And **the LORD spake unto Moses face to face, as a man speaketh unto his friend.** And he turned again into the camp: **but his servant Joshua, the son of Nun, a young man, departed not out of the tabernacle.**

John 10:2-4, 7-10

9 **I am the door:** by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and **shall go in and out,** and find pasture.

10 **The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy:** I am come **that they might have life,** and that they might have it more abundantly.

2 Chronicles 7:14-16

14 If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.

15 Now **mine eyes shall be open, and mine ears attentive unto the prayer that is made in this place.**

16 For now have **I chosen and sanctified this house, that my name may be there forever:** and **mine eyes and mine heart shall be there perpetually.**

❖ 2 Chronicles 7:16 (NIV)

I have chosen and consecrated **this temple** so that my Name (Christ) may be there forever. My eyes and my heart will always be there.

❖ 2 Samuel 22:7

In my distress I called upon the LORD, and cried to my God: and **he did hear my voice out of his temple,** and **my cry did enter into his ears.**

Matthew 6:6-13

6 But thou, **when thou prayest, enter into thy closet,** and **when thou hast shut thy door, pray to thy Father which is in secret;** and **thy Father which seeth in secret shall reward thee openly.**

7 But when ye pray, use not vain repetitions, as the heathen do: for **they think that they shall be heard for their much speaking.**

8 Be not ye therefore like unto them: for **your Father knoweth what things ye have need of, before ye ask him.**

9 After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.

10 Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.

11 Give us this day our daily bread.

12 And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.

13 And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever. Amen.

John 15:7-8

If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.

Luke 11:1-4

1 And it came to pass, that, as he was praying in a certain place, when he ceased, one of his disciples said unto him, **Lord, teach us to pray,** as John also taught his disciples.

2 And he said unto them, **When ye pray, say, Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, as in heaven, so in earth.**

3 Give us day by day our daily bread.

4 And forgive us our sins; for we also forgive every one that is indebted to us. And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil.

- ❖ **Come** Strong's - erchomai (er'-khom-ahee) G2064 - to come or go. Thayers - to come from one place to another. *Ex. To transfer from jurisdiction to another.*
- ❖ **Done** Strong's - ginomai (ghin'-om-ahee) G1096 - to become, to come into being, to be brought. to pass. Thayer's - to come into existence, begin to be, receive being; to come to pass, come upon the stage. Of miracles, to be performed, wrought

Luke 11:9-13

9 And **I say unto you, Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you.**

10 For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.

11 If a son shall ask bread of any of you that is a father, will he give him a stone? or if he ask a fish, will he for a fish give him a serpent?

12 Or if he shall ask an egg, will he offer him a scorpion?

13 **If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask him?**

- ❖ We all have “received” the Holy Spirit as a gift from the Father and Lord Jesus. The importance of the Holy Spirit is monumental, in that He is responsible transferring the Kingdom from the jurisdiction of Heaven to the jurisdiction of the earth “in you and through you” (Thy Kingdom Come). Secondly, He is also responsible for the demonstration or materialization of the Spiritual Kingdom of God into the natural Kingdom of this Earth. (Thy Will Be Done)

John 16:14-15 AMP

14 He will honor and glorify Me, because He will take of (receive, draw upon) what is Mine and will reveal (declare, disclose, transmit) it to you.

15 Everything that the Father has is Mine. That is what I meant when I said that He [the Spirit] will take the things that are Mine and will reveal (declare, disclose, transmit) it to you.

Mark 11:15-17, 22-26

22 And Jesus answering saith unto them, **Have faith in God.**

23 For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.⁷⁸

24 Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

25 And when ye stand praying, forgive, (prayed from the temple within – Matt 6:6) if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses.

26 But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses.

❖ **Definition of Receive:** Strong's G2983 - lambanō

Thayer Definition: To take up a thing to be carried, to take what is one's own, , to make one's own, to claim, procure for one's self, of that which when taken is not let go, to seize, to lay hold of, apprehend, take possession of, i.e. to appropriate to one's self, to receive what is offered

Dictionary Definition: Come into possession of, act as a receptacle or container, to permit to enter, take delivery of something

Luke 12:32

Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.

Matthew 10:7-8

7 And as ye go, preach, saying, The kingdom of heaven is at hand.

8 Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give.

Acts 3:1-2, 6

1 Now Peter and John went up together into the temple at the hour of prayer, being the ninth hour.

2 And a certain man lame from his mother's womb was carried, whom they laid daily at the gate of the temple which is called Beautiful, to ask alms of them that entered into the temple;

6 Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk.

Acts 4:29-33

29 And now, Lord, behold their threatenings: and grant unto thy servants, that with all boldness they may speak thy word,

30 By stretching forth thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus.

31 And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness.

32 And the multitude of them that believed were of one heart and of one soul: neither said any of them that ought of the things which he possessed was his own; but they had all things common.

33 And with great power gave the apostles witness of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus: and great grace was upon them all.

Psalms 84:11

For the LORD God is a sun and shield: **the LORD will give grace and glory: no good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly.**

Psalms 85:12-13

12 Yea, **the LORD shall give that which is good; and our land shall yield her increase.**

13 Righteousness shall go before him; and shall set us in the way of his steps.

Matthew 6:33

Seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and **all these things shall be added unto you.**

Romans 8:31-32

31 What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us?

32 He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, **how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?**
