Riches in Glory - Riches of His Grace

Hebrews 4:16

Let us therefore come boldly unto the Throne of Grace, that we may **obtain mercy, and find grace** to help in time of need.

Romans 5:2

By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

Ephesians 1:18

18 The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints,

Philippians 4:19

But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

Ephesians 1:7

In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;

Ephesians 3:7-8

- 7 Whereof I was made a minister, according to the gift of the grace of God given unto me by the effectual working of his power.
- 8 Unto me, who am less than the least of all saints, is this grace given, that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ;

Ephesians 1:3

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who <u>hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in</u> <u>heavenly places in Christ:</u>

RICHES IN GLORY

Acts 20:32

And now, brethren, I commend you to God, and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up, and to give you an inheritance among all them which are sanctified.

Isaiah 53:3-5

- 3 He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not.
- 4 Surely he hath borne our griefs (sicknesses), and carried our sorrows: (pains) yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.
- 5 But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: **the chastisement of our peace** (lack of peace) was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

Deuteronomy 25:1-3

- 1 **If there be a controversy between men**, and they come unto judgment, that the judges may judge them; then they shall justify the righteous, and condemn the wicked.
- 2 And it shall be, if the wicked man be worthy to be beaten, that the judge shall cause him to lie down, and to be beaten before his face, according to his fault, by a certain number.
- **3** Forty stripes he may give him, and not exceed: lest, if he should exceed, and beat him above these with many stripes, then thy brother should seem vile unto thee.

Hebrews 1:1-3

- 1 God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets,
- 2 Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds;
- 3 Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and <u>upholding all things by the word of his power</u>, when he had by himself purged our sins, <u>sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;</u>

Daniel 7:13-14

- 13 I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him.
- 14 And there was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed.

Psalms 22:28

For the kingdom is the LORD'S: and he is the governor among the nations.

Revelation 5:11-12 7 Fold Inheritance

- 11 And I beheld, and I heard the voice of many angels round about the throne and the beasts and the elders: and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands;
- 12 Saying with a loud voice, <u>Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing.</u>

Matthew 28:18

And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.

Philippians 2:9

Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name:

Psalms 2:6-8

- 6 Yet have I set my king upon my holy hill of Zion.
- 7 I will declare the decree: the LORD hath said unto me, Thou art my Son; this day have I begotten thee.
- 8 Ask of me, and I shall give thee the heathen (nations) for thine inheritance, and the uttermost parts of the earth for thy possession.

❖ Acts 13:33

God hath fulfilled the same unto us their children, in that <u>he hath raised up Jesus again</u>; as it is also written in the second psalm, Thou art my Son, this day have I begotten thee.

John 5:26-27

- 26 For as the Father hath life in himself; so hath he given to the Son to have life in himself;
- 27 And hath given him authority to execute judgment also, because he is the Son of man.

Isaiah 65:9

And I will bring forth a seed out of Jacob, and <u>out of Judah an inheritor of my mountains</u>: (Mt Hebron) and mine elect shall inherit it, and my servants shall dwell there.

Ephesians 4:8-13

- 8 Wherefore he saith, When he ascended up on high, he led captivity captive, and gave gifts unto men.
- 9 (Now that he ascended, what is it but that he also descended first into the lower parts of the earth?
- 10 He that descended is the same also that ascended up far above all heavens, that he might fill all things.)
- 11 And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers;
 - ❖ Psalms 68:18-19 Thou <u>hast ascended on high</u>, thou hast led captivity captive: thou <u>hast received gifts</u> for men...

THE TWO OLIVE TREES - (ZERUBBABEL - KING) (JOSHUA - PRIEST)

Zechariah 4:2-6, 11-14

- 2 And said unto me, What seest thou? And I said, I have looked, and behold a candlestick all of gold, with a bowl upon the top of it, and his seven lamps thereon, and seven pipes to the seven lamps, which are upon the top thereof:
- 3 And two olive trees by it, one upon the right side of the bowl, and the other upon the left side thereof.
- 4 So I answered and spake to the angel that talked with me, saying, What are these, my lord?
- 5 Then the angel that talked with me answered and said unto me, Knowest thou not what these be? And I said, No, my lord.
- 6 Then he answered and spake unto me, saying, This is the word of the LORD unto Zerubbabel, saying, **Not by** might, nor by power, but by my spirit, saith the LORD of hosts.
- 11 Then answered I, and said unto him, What are these two olive trees upon the right side of the candlestick and upon the left side thereof?
- 12 And I answered again, and said unto him, What be these two olive branches which through the two golden pipes empty the golden oil out of themselves?
- 13 And he answered me and said, Knowest thou not what these be? And I said, No, my lord.
- 14 Then said he, These are the two anointed ones, that stand by the Lord of the whole earth.

THE MELCHISEDEC GOVERNMENT

Genesis 14:18-20

- 18 And Melchizedek king of Salem brought forth bread and wine: and he was the priest of the most high God.
- 19 And he blessed him, and said, Blessed be Abram of the most high God, possessor of heaven and earth:
- 20 And blessed be the most high God, which hath delivered thine enemies into thy hand. And he gave him tithes of all.

Hebrews 7:1-3, 11, 15-17

- 1 For this <u>Melchisedec, king of Salem, priest of the most high God</u>, who met Abraham returning from the slaughter of the kings, and blessed him;
- 2 To whom also Abraham gave a tenth part of all; first being by interpretation King of righteousness, and after that also King of Salem, which is, King of peace;
- 3 Without father, without mother, without descent, having neither beginning of days, nor end of life; **but made** like unto the Son of God; abideth a priest continually.
- 11 If therefore perfection were by the Levitical priesthood, (for under it the people received the law,) what further need was there that <u>another priest should rise after the order of Melchisedec</u>, and not be called after the order of Aaron?
- 15 And it is yet far more evident: for that after the similitude of Melchisedec there ariseth another priest,
- 16 Who is made, not after the law of a carnal commandment, but after the power of an endless life.
- 17 For he testifieth, Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec.

THE TWO RIVERS

Ezekiel 47:1-12

- 1 Afterward he brought me again unto the door of the house; and, behold, waters issued out from under the threshold of the house eastward: for the forefront of the house stood toward the east, and the waters came down from under from the right side of the house, at the south side of the altar.
- 2 Then brought he me out of the way of the gate northward, and led me about the way without unto the utter gate by the way that looketh eastward; and, behold, there ran out waters on the right side.
- 3 And when the man that had the line in his hand went forth eastward, he measured a thousand cubits, and he brought me through the waters; the waters were to the ankles.
- 4 Again he measured a thousand, and brought me through the waters; the waters were to the knees. Again he measured a thousand, and brought me through; the waters were to the loins.
- 5 Afterward he measured a thousand; and <u>it was a river that I could not pass over: for the waters were risen,</u> <u>waters to swim in, a river that could not be passed over.</u>
- 6 And he said unto me, Son of man, hast thou seen this? Then he brought me, and caused me to return to the brink of the river.
- 7 Now when I had returned, behold, at the bank of the river were very many trees on the one side and on the other.
- 8 Then said he unto me, <u>These waters issue out toward the east country</u>, and go down into the desert, and go into the sea: (dead sea) which being brought forth into the sea, the waters shall be healed.
- 9 And it shall come to pass, that everything that liveth, which moveth, whithersoever the rivers shall come, shall live: and there shall be a very great multitude of fish, because these waters shall come thither: for they shall be healed; and everything shall live whither the river cometh.
- 10 And it shall come to pass, that the fishers shall stand upon it from Engedi even unto Eneglaim; they shall be a place to spread forth nets; their fish shall be according to their kinds, as the fish of the great sea, exceeding many.
- 11 But the miry places thereof and the marishes thereof shall not be healed; they shall be given to salt.
- 12 And by the river upon the bank thereof, on this side and on that side, shall grow all trees for meat, whose leaf shall not fade, neither shall the fruit thereof be consumed: it shall bring forth new fruit according to his months, because their waters they issued out of the sanctuary: and the fruit thereof shall be for meat, and the leaf thereof for medicine.

Zechariah 14:8

And it shall be in that day that <u>living waters shall go out from Jerusalem, half of them to the eastern [Dead] Sea</u> and <u>half of them to the western [Mediterranean] Sea;</u> in summer and in winter shall it be.
