JURISDICTIONAL ONENESS

John 1:17-18

No man hath seen God at any time; the only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared him.

John 8:28-29

<u>He that sent me is with me: the Father hath not left me alone;</u> for I do always those things that please him.

John 10:30, 36-38

30 I and my Father are one.

- 36 Say ye of him, whom the Father hath sanctified, and sent into the world, Thou blasphemest; because I said, I am the Son of God?
- 37 If I do not the works of my Father, believe me not.
- 38 But if I do, though ye believe not me, believe the works: that ye may know, and believe, that the Father is in me (Earthly Jurisdiction), and I in him. (Heavenly Jurisdiction)

John 14:8-11, 19-20, 23-24

- 8 Philip saith unto him, Lord, shew us the Father, and it sufficeth us.
- 9 Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou then, Shew us the Father?
- 10 Believest thou not that I am in the Father, (Heavenly Jurisdiction) and the Father in me? (Earthly Jurisdiction), the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works. (Earthly Jurisdiction),
- 11 Believe me that <u>I am in the Father</u>, (Heavenly Jurisdiction) <u>and the Father in me:</u> (Earthly Jurisdiction), or else believe me for the very works' sake.
- 19 Yet a little while, and the world seeth me no more; but ye see me: because I live, ye shall live also.
- 20 At that day ye shall know that <u>l am in my Father, and ye in me,</u> (Heavenly Jurisdiction) and I in you. (Earthly Jurisdiction),
- 23 Jesus answered and said unto him, If a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, (Heavenly Jurisdiction) and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him. (Earthly Jurisdiction),

John 15:4-8

- 4 <u>Abide in me</u>, (Heavenly Jurisdiction) <u>and I in you.</u> (Earthly Jurisdiction), As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me.
- 7 <u>If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.</u>
 - ❖ 1 John 2:5

But whoso keepeth his word, in him verily is the love of God perfected: hereby know we that we are in him. (Heavenly Jurisdiction)

John 16:32

Behold, the hour cometh, yea, is now come, that ye shall be scattered, every man to his own, and shall leave me alone: and yet I am not alone, because the Father is with me. (Earthly Jurisdiction)

THE UPPER ROOM PRAYER

John 17:20-23

- 20 Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word;
- 21 That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: (Heavenly Jurisdiction) that the world may believe that thou hast sent me.
- 22 And the glory which thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one: (thought continues to vs. 23)
- 23 <u>I in them, and thou in me</u>,(Earthly Jurisdiction John 14:23) <u>that they may be made perfect in one</u>; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and <u>hast loved them, as thou hast loved me.</u>

John 17:24-26

- 24 <u>Father, I will that they also, whom thou hast given me, be with me where I am; that they may behold my glory,</u> (Heavenly Jurisdiction) which thou hast given me: for thou lovedst me before the foundation of the world.
- 25 O righteous Father, the world hath not known thee: but I have known thee, and these have known that thou hast sent me.
- 26 And I have declared unto them thy name, and will declare it: that the love wherewith thou hast loved me may be in them, and I in them. (Earthly Jurisdiction)

GOD IS NOW OUR FATHER

John 20:16-17

- 16 Jesus saith unto her, Mary. She turned herself, and saith unto him, Rabboni; which is to say, Master.
- 17 Jesus saith unto her, Touch me not; for I am not yet ascended to my Father: but go to my brethren, and say unto them, I ascend unto my Father, and your Father; and to my God, and your God.

1 John 4:15-18

- 15 Whosoever shall confess that Jesus is the Son of God, God dwelleth in him, and he in God.
- 16 And we have known and believed the love that God hath to us. God is love; and he that dwelleth in love dwelleth in God, (Heavenly Jurisdiction) and God in him. (Earthly Jurisdiction)
- 17 Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because as he is, (Heavenly Jurisdiction) so are we in this world. (Earthly Jurisdiction)
- 18 There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love.
