

## KINGDOM DEBT BUSTER - CREDIT CARDS

### REVIEW

John 6:5-13

5 When Jesus then lifted up his eyes, and saw a great company come unto him, he saith unto Philip, Whence shall we buy bread, that these may eat?

6 And this he said to prove him: for he himself knew what he would do.

7 **Philip answered him, Two hundred pennyworth of bread is not sufficient for them, that every one of them may take a little.**

8 One of his disciples, **Andrew**, Simon Peter's brother, saith unto him,

9 **There is a lad here, which hath five barley loaves, and two small fishes: but what are they among so many?**

10 And Jesus said, **Make the men sit down.** Now there was much grass in the place. So the men sat down, in number about five thousand.

11 And **Jesus took the loaves; and when he had given thanks, he distributed to the disciples, and the disciples to them that were set down;** and likewise of the fishes as much as they would.

12 When they were filled, he said unto his disciples, Gather up the fragments that remain, that nothing be lost.

13 Therefore they gathered them together, and **filled twelve baskets with the fragments** of the five barley loaves, which remained over and above unto them that had eaten.

He commanded the multitude to sit down on the grass, and took the five loaves, and the two fishes, **and looking up to heaven, he blessed, and broke, and gave the loaves to his disciples, and the disciples to the multitude.**

- ❖ **Break and Divide the Seed**
- ❖ **Distribute the Seed**

### GOD PROVIDES SEED FOR THE SOWING

2 Corinthians 9:8, 10

8 God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work:

10 **Now he that ministereth seed to the sower both minister bread for your food, and multiply your seed sown,** and increase the fruits of your righteousness;)

Isaiah 55:8-11

For as the rain cometh down, and the snow from heaven, and returneth not thither, but watereth the earth, and maketh it bring forth and bud, that **it may give seed to the sower, and bread to the eater:**

1. Revelation of the Kingdom and How It works
2. Faith in God. Faith in the Kingdom
3. Plan of Action
4. Discipline and Obedience to the Plan
5. Open New Debit Card Acct or Savings Acct

## **PLAN OF ACTION FOR CREDIT CARDS**

- Step 1 - Repent and Break Covenant with the spirit of mammon  
Step 2 - Begin with a Kingdom Activation Seed  
Step 3 - Release Faith into the First Seed, Bless the Seed / Present Seed into the Kingdom  
Step 4 - Anticipate Multiplication from First Seed (surplus, abundance beyond normal income)  
Step 5 - Receive the Seed through Thanksgiving (do not complain about the size of the seed)  
Step 6 - Bless the Seed via Kingdom Jurisdictional Transfer  
Step 7 - Break the Seed / Loaves of 1<sup>st</sup> Harvest via The 85 Principle  
Step 8 - Continue to Repeat through Faith and Obedience  
Step 9 - Speak to the Mountain

## **THE 85 PRINCIPLE**

- ❖ 10% to God
  - ❖ 85% to Debt,
  - ❖ 5% to Fund New Debit Card
- ❖ Debit Card Acct will be funded through 5% of all overflow. This will serve to build a new system of operating by cash while your credit card is being paid down.
