I AND MY FATHER WILL DWELL WITH YOU IN THE EARTH

John 14:23

Jesus answered and said unto him, If a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and **we will come unto him, and make our abode with him.**

John 14:20

At that day ye shall know that **I am in my Father, and ye in me, and I in you.**

John 15:4

Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me.

John 17:20-23, 24-26

20 Neither pray I for these alone, **but for them also which shall believe on me through their word;**
21 That they all may be one; as thou, **Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us:**
that the world may believe that thou hast sent me.

22 And the glory which thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one:

23 **I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one;** and **that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me.**

24 **Father, I will that they also, whom thou hast given me, be with me where I am;** that they may behold my glory, which thou hast given me: **for thou lovedst me before the foundation of the world.**

25 O righteous Father, the world hath not known thee: but I have known thee, and these have known that thou hast sent me.

26 And I have declared unto them thy name, and will declare it: **that the love wherewith thou hast loved me may be in them, and I in them.**

❖ John 13:35

By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.

JESUS AND THE FATHER - OUR EXAMPLE

John 14:6-7

6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

7 **If ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also:** and **from henceforth ye know him, and have seen him.**

THE FATHER SPEAKS DIRECTLY THROUGH CHRIST

John 14:8-11

8 Philip saith unto him, Lord, shew us the Father, and it sufficeth us.

9 **Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father;** and how sayest thou then, Shew us the Father?

10 **Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me?** the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but **the Father that dwelleth in me,** he doeth the works.

11 **Believe me that I am in the Father, and the Father in me:** or else believe me for the very works' sake.

John 2:18-19

18 Then answered the Jews and said unto him, What sign shewest thou unto us, seeing that thou doest these things?

19 **Jesus answered and said unto them, Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up.**

❖ Galatians 1:1

Paul, an apostle, (not of men, neither by man, but by Jesus Christ, **and God the Father, who raised him from the dead;**

John 8:29, 38

29 **He that sent me is with me: the Father hath not left me alone;** for I do always those things that please him.

38 **I speak that which I have seen with my Father:** and ye do that which ye have seen with your father.

John 10:30

I and my Father are one.

John 12:44-45

44 Jesus cried and said, **He that believeth on me, believeth not on me, but on him that sent me.**

45 And **he that seeth me seeth him that sent me.**

John 15:23-24

23 He that hateth me hateth my Father also.

24 If I had not done among them the works which none other man did, they had not had sin: **but now have they both seen and hated both me and my Father.**

John 5:19, 30

19 Then answered Jesus and said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, **The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do:** for what things soever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise.

30 **I can of mine own self do nothing:** as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent me.

John 7:16

Jesus answered them, and said, **My doctrine is not mine, but his that sent me.** (that is with me)

GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE - THE FATHER WAS WITH CHRIST AT THE CROSS

John 16:32

Behold, the hour cometh, yea, is now come, that ye shall be scattered, every man to his own, and shall leave me alone: and yet I am not alone, because the Father is with me.

Matthew 26:36-39, 42, 44

36 Then cometh Jesus with them unto a place called Gethsemane, and saith unto the disciples, Sit ye here, while I go and pray yonder.

37 And he took with him Peter and the two sons of Zebedee, and began to be sorrowful and very heavy.

38 Then saith he unto them, My soul is exceeding sorrowful, even unto death: tarry ye here, and watch with me.

39 And he went a little further, and fell on his face, and prayed, saying, O my Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me: nevertheless not as I will, but as thou wilt.

42 He went away again the second time, and prayed, saying, O my Father, if this cup may not pass away from me, except I drink it, thy will be done

44 And he left them, and went away again, and prayed the third time, saying the same words...

❖ Luke 22: 44

... and his sweat was as it were great drops of blood falling down to the ground.

John 18:6

4 Jesus therefore, knowing all things that should come upon him, went forth, and said unto them, Whom seek ye?

5 They answered him, Jesus of Nazareth. Jesus saith unto them, I am he. And Judas also, which betrayed him, stood with them.

6 As soon then as he had said unto them, I am he, they went backward, and fell to the ground.

Matthew 26:53

Thinkest thou that I cannot now pray to my Father, and he shall presently give me more than twelve legions of angels?

Luke 22:51

50 And one of them smote the servant of the high priest, and cut off his right ear.

51 And Jesus answered and said, Suffer ye thus far. And he touched his ear, and healed him.

Matthew 27:45-50

45 Now from the sixth hour there was darkness over all the land unto the ninth hour.

46 And about the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani? that is to say, My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me? (abandoned, deserted, departed, left)

47 Some of them that stood there, when they heard that, said, This man calleth for Elias.

48 And straightway one of them ran, and took a sponge, and filled it with vinegar, and put it on a reed, and gave him to drink.

49 The rest said, Let be, let us see whether Elias will come to save him.

50 Jesus, when he had cried again with a loud voice, yielded up the ghost.
