I WILL #1 > I WILL COME TO YOU BY WAY OF THE HOLY SPIRIT AND HE WILL GLORIFY ME

John 14:2-3

2 In my Father's house are **many mansions** (dwelling places) : if it were not so, I would have told you.

I go to prepare a place for you.

3 And **if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again,** and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.

John 14:16-18

16 I will pray the Father, and **he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you forever;**

17 Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for He dwelleth with you, and shall be in you.

18 **I will not leave you comfortless** (fatherless): **I will come to you.**

John 16:7-14

7 Nevertheless I tell you the truth; **It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you;** but **if I depart, I will send him unto you.**

8 And when he is come, **he will reprove** (convict, convince) **the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:**

9 Of sin, because they believe not on me;

10 Of righteousness, because I go to my Father, and ye see me no more;

11 Of judgment, because the prince of this world is judged.

12 I have yet many things to say unto you, but ye cannot bear them now.

13 Howbeit when **he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth:** for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and **he will shew you things to come.**

14 **He shall glorify me: he shall receive of mine and shall shew it unto you.** (who, what, where I am)

- ❖ **To Come** John 16:13 (Greek - er-chomai) - to come or go, to make one’s appearance. Thayers: to come from one place to another. “Jurisdictional Transfer”
- ❖ John 10:9 **I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture.**

I WILL # 2 > I WILL RECEIVE AND ACCEPT YOU UNTO MYSELF "WHERE I AM"

John 14:2-3

2 In my Father's house are many mansions (dwelling places) : if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.

3 And **if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again,** and **receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.**

John 17:24

24 **Father, I will** that they also, whom thou hast given me, **be with me where I am; that they may behold my glory,** which thou hast given me: for thou lovedst me before the foundation of the world.

John 12:26

If any man serve me, **let him follow me; and where I am, there shall also my servant be;** if any man serve me, him will my Father honour.

John 13:36-38

36 Simon Peter said unto him, Lord, whither goest thou? Jesus answered him, **Whither I go, thou canst not follow me now; but thou shalt follow me afterwards.**

37 Peter said unto him, Lord, why cannot I follow thee now? I will lay down my life for thy sake.

38 Jesus answered him, Wilt thou lay down thy life for my sake? Verily, verily, I say unto thee, The cock shall not crow, till thou hast denied me thrice.

Ephesians 1:4-6

4 According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, **that we should be holy and without blame before him in love:**

5 Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will,

6 To the praise of the glory of his grace, **wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved.**

INVITATIONS TO COME

John 15:4-5, 7

4 **Abide in me,** and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me.

5 I am the vine, ye are the branches: **He that abideth in me,** and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: **for without me ye can do nothing.**

7 **If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you,** ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done.

John 7:33-37

In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, **if any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink.**

Matthew 11:28

Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

I WILL # 3 > I WILL REVEAL THE FATHER'S LOVE AND GLORY TO YOU "WHERE I AM"

John 13:30-31

30 He then having received the sop went immediately out: and it was night.

31 Therefore, when he was gone out, Jesus said, **Now is the Son of man glorified, and God is glorified in (by, through) him.**

John 17:1, 5

1 These words spake Jesus, and lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, Father, the hour is come; **glorify thy Son, that thy Son also may glorify thee:**

5 And now, **O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was.**

John 14: 2, 6-7, 10-11, 19-20

2 **In my Father's house are many mansions** (Dwelling Places): if it were not so, I would have told you. **I go to prepare a place for you.** (In the Father)

6 Jesus saith unto him, **I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.**

7 If ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also: and **from henceforth ye know him,** and have seen him.

10 **Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me?** the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but **the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works.**

11 **Believe me that I am in the Father, and the Father in me:** or else believe me for the very works' sake.

19 **Yet a little while,** and the world seeth me no more; **but ye see me:** because I live, ye shall live also.

20 **At that day "ye shall know" that I am in my Father, and ye in me, and I in you.**

❖ **Know** (Ginosko) - To know absolutely and intimately. Jewish idiom for sexual intercourse.

John 16:16-17, 25

16 **A little while,** and ye shall not see me: **and again, a little while, and ye shall see me, because I go to the Father.**

25 **These things have I spoken unto you in proverbs: but the time cometh, when I shall no more speak unto you in proverbs, but I shall shew you plainly (openly) of the Father.**

John 17:1, 5, 13

1 These words spake Jesus, and lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, Father, the hour is come; **glorify thy Son, that thy Son also may glorify thee:**

5 And now, **O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was.**

13 And **now come I to thee; and these things I speak in the world, that they might have my joy fulfilled in themselves.**

John 17:21-26

21 That they all may be one; as thou, **Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us;** that the world may believe that thou hast sent me.

22 **The glory which thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one:**

23 I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one; and **that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me.**

24 **Father, I will that they also, whom thou hast given me, be with me where I am; that they may behold my glory, which thou hast given me: for thou lovedst me before the foundation of the world.**

25 O righteous Father, the world hath not known thee: but I have known thee, and these have known that thou hast sent me.

26 And I have declared unto them thy name, and will declare it: **that the love wherewith thou hast loved me may be in them, and I in them.**

John 14:22-23

22 Judas saith unto him, not Iscariot, Lord, how is it that thou wilt manifest thyself unto us, and not unto the world?

23 Jesus answered and said unto him, **if a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him,** and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him.

1 John 4:16-19

16 **We have known and believed the love that God hath to us. God is love; and he that dwelleth in love dwelleth in God, and God in him.**

17 Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because as he is, so are we in this world.

18 There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love.

19 **We love him, because he first loved us.**

John 20:16-17

16 Jesus saith unto her, Mary. She turned herself, and saith, Rabboni; which is to say, Master.

17 Jesus saith unto her, Touch me not; for I am not yet ascended to my Father: but go to my brethren, and say to them, **I ascend unto my Father, and your Father; and to my God, and your God.**

Jude 1:24

Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and **to present you faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy,**

Colossians 1:21-22

21 You that were sometime alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now hath he reconciled

22 In the body of his flesh through death, **to present you holy and unblameable and unreprouvable in his sight:**
