I WILL #1 > I WILL COME TO YOU BY WAY OF THE HOLY SPIRIT AND HE WILL GLORIFY ME

John 14:2-3

- 2 In my Father's house are <u>many mansions</u> (dwelling places): if it were not so, I would have told you. <u>I go to prepare a place for you.</u>
- 3 And <u>if I go and prepare a place for you</u>, <u>I will come again</u>, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.

John 14:16-18

- 16 I will pray the Father, and <u>he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you</u> forever;
- 17 Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for He dwelleth with you, and shall be in you.
- 18 I will not leave you comfortless (fatherless): I will come to you.

John 16:7-14

- 7 Nevertheless I tell you the truth; <u>It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you;</u> but <u>if I depart, I will send him unto you.</u>
- 8 And when he is come, <u>he will reprove</u> (convict, convince) <u>the world of sin, and of righteousness</u>, and of judgment:
- 9 Of sin, because they believe not on me;
- 10 Of righteousness, because I go to my Father, and ye see me no more;
- 11 Of judgment, because the prince of this world is judged.
- 12 I have yet many things to say unto you, but ye cannot bear them now.
- 13 Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.
- 14 He shall glorify me: he shall receive of mine and shall shew it unto you. (who, what, where I am)
 - **To Come** John 16:13 (Greek er-chomai) to come or go, to make one's appearance. Thayers: to come from one place to another. "Jurisdictional Transfer"
 - John 10:9 <u>I am the door: by me if any man enter in</u>, <u>he shall be saved</u>, <u>and shall go in and out</u>, and find pasture.

I WILL # 2 > I WILL RECEIVE AND ACCEPT YOU UNTO MYSELF "WHERE I AM"

John 14:2-3

- 2 In my Father's house are many mansions (dwelling places): if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.
- 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.

John 17:24

24 <u>Father, I will</u> that they also, whom thou hast given me, <u>be with me where I am</u>; <u>that they may behold my glory</u>, which thou hast given me: for thou lovedst me before the foundation of the world.

- 36 Simon Peter said unto him, Lord, whither goest thou? Jesus answered him, Whither I go, thou canst not follow me now; but thou shalt follow me afterwards.
- 37 Peter said unto him, Lord, why cannot I follow thee now? I will lay down my life for thy sake.
- 38 Jesus answered him, Wilt thou lay down thy life for my sake? Verily, verily, I say unto thee, The cock shall not crow, till thou hast denied me thrice.

Ephesians 1:4-6

- 4 According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, **that we should be holy** and without blame before him in love:
- 5 Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will,
- 6 To the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved.

John 15:4-5, 7

- 4 <u>Abide in me</u>, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me.
- 5 I am the vine, ye are the branches: **He that abideth in me**, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: **for without me ye can do nothing.**
- 7 If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done.

John 7:33-37

In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink.

Matthew 11:28

Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

John 13:30-31

- 30 He then having received the sop went immediately out: and it was night.
- 31 Therefore, when he was gone out, Jesus said, Now is the Son of man glorified, and God is glorified in (by, through) him.

John 17:1, 5

- 1 These words spake Jesus, and lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, Father, the hour is come; glorify thy Son, that thy Son also may glorify thee:
- 5 And now, <u>O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was.</u>

John 14: 2, 6-7, 10-11, 19-20

- 2 <u>In my Father's house are many mansions</u> (Dwelling Places): if it were not so, I would have told you. <u>I go to prepare a place for you</u>. (In the Father)
- 6 Jesus saith unto him, <u>I am the way, the truth, and the life</u>: <u>no man cometh unto the Father, but by</u> me.
- 7 If ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also: and from henceforth ye know him, and have seen him.
- 10 <u>Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me?</u> the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but <u>the Father that dwelleth in me</u>, <u>he doeth the works.</u>
- 11 <u>Believe me that I am in the Father, and the Father in me</u>: or else believe me for the very works' sake.
- 19 <u>Yet a little while</u>, and the world seeth me no more; <u>but ye see me</u>: because I live, ye shall live also.
- 20 At that day "ye shall know" that I am in my Father, and ye in me, and I in you.
 - **Know** (Ginosko) To know absolutely and intimately. Jewish idiom for sexual intercourse.

John 16:16-17, 25

- 16 <u>A little while</u>, and ye shall not see me: <u>and again, a little while, and ye shall see me</u>, <u>because I go</u> to the Father.
- 25 These things have I spoken unto you in proverbs: but the time cometh, when I shall no more speak unto you in proverbs, but I shall shew you plainly (openly) of the Father.

John 17:1, 5, 13

- 1 These words spake Jesus, and lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, Father, the hour is come; glorify thy Son, that thy Son also may glorify thee:
- 5 And now, <u>O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee</u> before the world was.
- 13 And now come I to thee; and these things I speak in the world, that they might have my joy fulfilled in themselves.

John 17:21-26

- 21 That they all may be one; as thou, <u>Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in</u> <u>us:</u> that the world may believe that thou hast sent me.
- 22 The glory which thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one:
- 23 I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me.
- 24 Father, I will that they also, whom thou hast given me, be with me where I am; that they may behold my glory, which thou hast given me: for thou lovedst me before the foundation of the world.
- 25 O righteous Father, the world hath not known thee: but I have known thee, and these have known that thou hast sent me.
- 26 And I have declared unto them thy name, and will declare it: that the love wherewith thou hast loved me may be in them, and I in them.

John 14:22-23

- 22 Judas saith unto him, not Iscariot, Lord, how is it that thou wilt manifest thyself unto us, and not unto the world?
- 23 Jesus answered and said unto him, <u>If a man love me, he will keep my words</u>: <u>and my Father will</u> <u>love him</u>, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him.

1 John 4:16-19

- 16 We have known and believed the love that God hath to us. God is love; and he that dwelleth in love dwelleth in God, and God in him.
- 17 Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because as he is, so are we in this world.
- 18 There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love.
- 19 We love him, because he first loved us.

John 20:16-17

- 16 Jesus saith unto her, Mary. She turned herself, and saith, Rabboni; which is to say, Master.
- 17 Jesus saith unto her, Touch me not; for I am not yet ascended to my Father: but go to my brethren, and say to them, I ascend unto my Father, and your Father; and to my God, and your God.

Jude 1:24

Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy,

Colossians 1:21-22

- 21 You that were sometime alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now hath he reconciled
- 22 In the body of his flesh through death, to present you holy and unblameable and unreproveable in his sight:
