THE GOLDEN LAMPSTAND - THE NAIL

REVIEW

Zechariah 4:2-3, 6-7

- 2 And said unto me, What seest thou? And I said, I have looked, and behold a candlestick all of gold, with a bowl upon the top of it, and his seven lamps thereon, and seven pipes to the seven lamps, which are upon the top thereof:
- 3 And two olive trees by it, one upon the right side of the bowl, and the other upon the left side thereof.

JOHN SEES 7 LAMPS AS THINGS TO COME

Revelation 4:1, 5

- 1 After this I looked, and, behold, a door was opened in heaven: and the first voice which I heard was as it were of a trumpet talking with me; which said, Come up hither, and I will shew thee things which must be hereafter.
- 5 Out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunderings and voices: and there were seven lamps of fire (torches) burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.

LAST DAY OUTPOURING OF THE 7 SPIRITS OF GOD - BRIDAL COMPANY REIGNING ON EARTH

Revelation 5:5-6, 10

- 5 And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Juda, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.
- 6 I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.
- 10 And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth.

Revelation 6:1-8

- 1 And <u>I saw when the Lamb opened one of the seals, and I heard, as it were the noise of thunder,</u> one of the four beasts saying, Come and see.
- 2 And I saw, and behold a white horse: and he that sat on him had a bow; and a crown was given unto him: and he went forth conquering, and to conquer. (Rev 5:10)

Zechariah 10:1

- 1 Ask ye of the LORD rain in the time of the latter rain; so the LORD shall make bright clouds, and give them showers of rain, to every one grass in the field.

The Corner - The Headstone of the Latter Rain

Zechariah 4:7

Who art thou, O great mountain? <u>before Zerubbabel thou shalt become a plain: and he shall bring forth the headstone thereof</u> with shoutings, crying, Grace, grace unto it.

The Nail - The Office of Treasury

Isaiah 22:15, 19-25

- 15 Thus saith the Lord GOD of hosts, Go, get thee unto this treasurer, even unto Shebna, which is over the house, and say,
- 19 And I will drive thee from thy station, and from thy state shall he pull thee down.
- 20 And it shall come to pass in that day, that I will call my servant Eliakim the son of Hilkiah:
- 21 And I will clothe him with thy robe, and strengthen him with thy girdle, and I will commit thy government into his hand: and he shall be a father to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and to the house of Judah.
- 22 And the key of the house of David will I lay upon his shoulder; so he shall open, and none shall shut; and he shall shut, and none shall open.
- 23 And <u>I will fasten him as a nail in a sure place</u>; and he shall be for a glorious throne to his father's house.
- 24 And they shall hang upon him all the glory of his father's house, the offspring and the issue, all vessels of small quantity, from the vessels of cups, even to all the vessels of flagons.
- 25 In that day, saith the LORD of hosts, shall the nail that is fastened in the sure place be removed, and be cut down, and fall; and the burden that was upon it shall be cut off: for the LORD hath spoken it.
 - ❖ Revelation 3:7-10
 - 7 And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write; These things saith he that is holy, he that is true, he that hath the key of David, he that openeth, and no man shutteth; and shutteth, and no man openeth;
 - 8 I know thy works: behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it: for thou hast a little strength, and hast kept my word, and hast not denied my name.
 - 9 Behold, I will make them of the synagogue of Satan, which say they are Jews, and are not, but do lie; behold, I will make them to come and worship before thy feet, and to know that I have loved thee.
 - 10 Because thou hast kept the word of my patience, I also will keep thee from the hour of temptation, which shall come upon all the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth.

The Battle Bow - The White Horse and Bow

Zechariah 10:5-6

- 5 And they shall be as mighty men, which tread down their enemies in the mire of the streets in the battle: and they shall fight, because the LORD is with them, and the riders on horses shall be confounded.
- 6 And I will strengthen the house of Judah, and I will save the house of Joseph, and I will bring them again to place them; for I have mercy upon them: and they shall be as though I had not cast them off: for I am the LORD their God, and will hear them.
 - Victorious over sin, sickness and poverty. Confounding the riders of the systems of this world

Psalms 45:3-7, 11 (Most likely written by David)

- 3 Gird thy sword upon thy thigh, O most mighty, with thy glory and thy majesty.
- 4 And <u>in thy majesty ride prosperously</u> because of truth and meekness and righteousness; and <u>thy right hand shall teach</u> (guide) <u>thee terrible</u> (wonderful) <u>things.</u>
- 5 Thine arrows are sharp in the heart of the king's enemies; whereby the people fall under thee.
- 6 Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever: the sceptre of thy kingdom is a right sceptre.
