THE HEART – THE BIRTHING CENTER OF HEAVEN

Luke 17:20-21

20 And when he was demanded of the Pharisees, when the kingdom of God should come, he answered them and said, <u>The kingdom of God cometh not with observation</u>:
21 Neither shall they say, Lo here! or, lo there! for, <u>behold, the kingdom of God is within you</u>.

Proverbs 4:23

Keep (guard) thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues (source springs) of life.

Proverbs 23:7

<u>For as he thinketh in his heart, so is he ...</u>

Thinketh (shaw-ar) - to open, that is, to act as gate keeper

Romans 10:10

For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Matthew 6:9-10

9 After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.

10 Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.

Mark 11:22, 24 22 And Jesus answering saith unto them, <u>Have faith in God</u>. (IN GOD ALONE)

24 Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

John 16:23-26

23 In that day ye shall ask me nothing. Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, he will give it you.
