THE ROD OF ZION

Psalms 110:1-4

1 A Psalm of David. The LORD said unto my Lord, <u>Sit thou at my right hand, until I make thine</u> enemies thy footstool.

2 **The LORD shall send the rod of thy strength out of Zion**: rule thou in the midst of thine enemies.

Psalms 16:8

I have set the LORD always before me: because he is at my right hand, I shall not be moved.

Matthew 4:17

From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

Exodus 2:11-12

11 And it came to pass in those days, <u>when Moses was grown, that he went out unto his brethren,</u> and looked on their burdens: and he spied an Egyptian smiting an Hebrew, one of his brethren.
12 And <u>he looked this way and that way, and when he saw that there was no man, he slew the</u> Egyptian, and hid him in the sand.

Acts 7:22-25, 30

22 And <u>Moses was learned in all the wisdom of the Egyptians</u>, and was <u>mighty in words and in</u> <u>deeds.</u>

23 And <u>when he was full forty years old</u>, it came into his heart to visit his brethren the children of Israel.

24 And seeing one of them suffer wrong, <u>he defended him, and avenged him that was</u> oppressed, and smote the Egyptian:

25 <u>For he supposed his brethren would have understood how that God by his hand</u> would <u>deliver them: but they understood not.</u>

30 And <u>when forty years were expired</u>, there appeared to him in the wilderness of mount Sina an angel of the Lord in a flame of fire in a bush.

Exodus 2:13-19

13 And when he went out the second day, behold, two men of the Hebrews strove together: and he said to him that did the wrong, Wherefore smitest thou thy fellow?

14 And he said, Who made thee a prince and a judge over us? intendest thou to kill me, as thou killedst the Egyptian? And Moses feared, and said, Surely this thing is known.

15 Now when Pharaoh heard this thing, he sought to slay Moses. But Moses fled from the face of Pharaoh, and dwelt in the land of Midian: and he sat down by a well.

16 Now the priest of Midian had seven daughters: and they came and drew water, and filled the troughs to water their father's flock.

17 And the shepherds came and drove them away: but <u>Moses stood up and helped them, and</u> <u>watered their flock.</u>

18 And when they came to Reuel their father, he said, How is it that ye are come so soon to day?

19 And they said, <u>An Egyptian delivered us out of the hand of the shepherds</u>, and also drew water enough for us, and watered the flock.

Exodus 3:1

1 Now Moses kept the flock of Jethro his father in law, the priest of Midian: and he led the flock to the backside of the desert, and came to the mountain of God, even to Horeb.

2 And the angel of the LORD appeared unto him in a flame of fire out of the midst of a bush: and he looked, and, behold, the bush burned with fire, and the bush was not consumed.

✤ Acts 7:30

When forty years were expired, there appeared to him in the wilderness of mount Sina an angel of the Lord in a flame of fire in a bush.

Exodus 4:17

Thou shalt take this rod in thine hand, wherewith thou shalt do signs.

Exodus 14:15-16

15 And the LORD said unto Moses, Wherefore criest thou unto me? speak unto the children of Israel, that they go forward:

16 But lift thou up thy rod, and stretch out thine hand over the sea, and divide it: and the children of Israel shall go on dry ground through the midst of the sea.

Exodus 17:8-16

8 Then came Amalek, and fought with Israel in Rephidim.

9 And Moses said unto Joshua, Choose us out men, and go out, fight with Amalek: tomorrow I will stand on the top of the hill with the rod of God in mine hand.

10 So Joshua did as Moses had said to him, and fought with Amalek: and Moses, Aaron, and Hur went up to the top of the hill.

11 And it came to pass, when Moses held up his hand, that Israel prevailed: and when he let down his hand, Amalek prevailed.

12 **But Moses' hands were heavy; and they took a stone, and put it under him, and he sat thereon**; and Aaron and Hur stayed up his hands, the one on the one side, and the other on the other side; and his hands were steady until the going down of the sun.

13 And Joshua discomfited Amalek and his people with the edge of the sword.

14 And the LORD said unto Moses, Write this for a memorial in a book, and rehearse it in the ears of Joshua: for I will utterly put out the remembrance of Amalek from under heaven.

15 And Moses built an altar, and called the name of it <u>Jehovahnissi</u>:

16 For he said, <u>Because the LORD hath sworn that the LORD will have war with Amalek from</u> generation to generation.
