THE TWO KINGDOMS

Luke 5:1-2

- 1 And it came to pass, that, as the people pressed upon him to hear the word of God, he stood by the lake of Gennesaret,
- 2 And saw <u>two ships standing by the lake</u>: but <u>the fishermen were gone out of them</u>, and <u>were washing their nets.</u>
 - Luke 5:5 ... Master, we have toiled all the night, and have taken nothing...
 - ❖ (NLT) v. 2 He noticed two empty boats at the water's edge ...
 - ❖ Why the wash the nets, if nothing was caught ? (entanglements, works, flesh, strife, offenses, trespasses, soulish pursuits, discouragement, confusion, fear etc...)

Luke 5:3

He entered into one of the ships, which was Simon's, and prayed him that he would thrust out a little from the land. And he sat down, and taught the people out of the ship.

- ❖ The Word / Kingdom entered once man had ceased from his own works. (Heb 4:10)
- ❖ The Word began to took possession of the vessel, causing separation and consecration
- ❖ The Word <u>Sat Down</u> (to set, appoint, confer a kingdom) in full possession of the vessel.
- The Word taught the multitudes shifted the priority, purposes & pursuits of the vessel.
- Peter never dreamed that Christ would preach out of the vessel...

Luke 5:4-5

- 4 Now when he had left speaking, he said unto Simon, Launch out into the deep, and let down your nets for a draught.
- 5 And Simon answering said unto him, Master, we have toiled all the night, and have taken nothing: nevertheless at thy word I will let down the net.
 - ❖ Who is in charge ? Man or Jesus ? Jesus did everything opposite of what Peter would do.
 - Who was directing the leadership, operations, direction of the blessing?

Luke 5:6-11

- 6 And when they had this done, they enclosed a great multitude of fishes: and their net brake.
- 7 And <u>they beckoned unto their partners</u>, <u>which were in the other ship</u>, <u>that they should come and help them</u>. And they came, and filled both the ships, so that they began to sink.
- 8 When Simon Peter saw it, he fell down at Jesus' knees, saying, Depart from me; for I am a sinful man, O Lord.
- 9 For he was astonished, and all that were with him, at the draught of the fishes which they had taken:
- 10 And so was also James, and John, the sons of Zebedee, which were partners with Simon. And Jesus said unto Simon, Fear not; from henceforth thou shalt catch men.
- 11 And when they had brought their ships to land, they forsook all, and followed him.
