THE WHITE HORSE

THE 7 SPIRITS OF GOD

Revelation 1:4-6

- 4 John to the seven churches which are in Asia: Grace be unto you, and peace, <u>from him which is, and which was, and which is to come</u>; <u>and from the seven Spirits which are before his throne</u>;
- 5 And from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, and the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood,
- 6 And hath made us kings and priests unto God and his Father; to him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

Revelation 3:7-9

- 7 To the angel (messenger) of the church in Philadelphia (brotherly Love) write; These things saith he that is holy, he that is true, he that hath the key of David, he that openeth, and no man shutteth; and shutteth, and no man openeth;
- 8 I know thy works: behold, <u>I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it</u>: <u>for thou hast a little strength, and hast kept my word, and hast not denied my name.</u>
- 10 <u>Because thou hast kept the word of my patience</u>, <u>I also will keep thee from the hour of temptation</u>, which shall come upon all the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth.
- 11 Behold, I come quickly: hold that fast which thou hast, that no man take thy crown.

Revelation 4:1-5

- 1 After this I looked, and, behold, a door was opened in heaven: and the first voice which I heard was as it were of a trumpet talking with me; which said, Come up hither, and I will shew thee things which must be hereafter.
- 5 And out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunderings and voices: and there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.

Revelation 5:6-10

- 6 I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.
- 7 And he came and took the book out of the right hand of him that sat upon the throne.
- 8 And when he had taken the book, the four beasts and four and twenty elders fell down before the Lamb, having every one of them harps, and golden vials (bowls) full of odours, (incense) which are the prayers of saints
- 9 And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation;
- 10 And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth.

THE WHITE HORSE OF THE LATTER RAIN - KINGS & PRIEST REIGNING ON THE EARTH

Revelation 6:1-8

- 1 And <u>I saw when the Lamb opened one of the seals, and I heard, as it were the noise of thunder,</u> one of the four beasts saying, Come and see.
- 2 And I saw, and behold a white horse: and he that sat on him had a bow; and a crown was given unto him: and he went forth conquering, and to conquer.
- 3 And when he had opened the second seal, I heard the second beast say, Come and see.
- 4 And there went out another horse that was red: and power was given to him that sat thereon to take peace from the earth, and that they should kill one another: and there was given unto him a great sword.
- 5 And when he had opened the third seal, I heard the third beast say, Come and see. And I beheld, and lo a black horse; and he that sat on him had a pair of balances in his hand.
- 6 And I heard a voice in the midst of the four beasts say, A measure of wheat for a penny, and three measures of barley for a penny; and see thou hurt not the oil and the wine.
- 7 And when he had opened the fourth seal, I heard the voice of the fourth beast say, Come and see.
- 8 And I looked, and behold a pale horse: and his name that sat on him was Death, and Hell followed with him. And power was given unto them over the fourth part of the earth, to kill with sword (Red Horse of war v. 4), and with hunger (Black Horse of famine v. 5-6), and with death (Pale Horse of death and hell) and with the beasts of the earth.

 - Pale Horse Death and Hell
 - Major Shift of Dispensation Between White Horse and Red Horse

THE GOODLY WAR HORSE OF THE LATTER RAIN

Zechariah 10:1, 3-4

- 1 <u>Ask ye of the LORD rain in the time of the latter rain</u>; so the LORD shall make bright clouds, and give them showers of rain, to every one grass in the field.
- 3 Mine anger was kindled against the shepherds, and I punished the goats: <u>for the LORD of hosts hath</u> <u>visited his flock the house of Judah</u>, and hath <u>made them as his goodly horse in the battle.</u>
- 4 <u>Out of him came forth the corner</u>, <u>out of him the nail</u>, <u>out of him the battle bow</u>, <u>out of him every</u> <u>oppressor together</u>. (They removed the oppressors from the land Zech 9:8)

 - ❖ The Battle Bow The White Horse and Bow (Rev 6:1)

Zechariah 10:5-6

5 And they shall be as mighty men, which tread down their enemies in the mire of the streets in the battle: and they shall fight, because the LORD is with them, and the riders on horses shall be confounded.
6 And will strengthen the house of Judah, and I will save the house of Joseph, and I will bring them again to place them; for I have mercy upon them: and they shall be as though I had not cast them off...
