

WHERE I AM - KINGDOM EXCHANGE

John 14:19-20

19 **Yet a little while**, and **the world seeth me no more; but ye see me**: because I live, ye shall live also.

20 **At that day ye shall know that I am in my Father, and ye in me, and I in you.**

John 16:16, 23-26

16 **A little while**, and ye shall not see me: and **again, a little while, and ye shall see me, because I go to the Father.**

23 **In that day** ye shall ask me nothing. Verily, verily, I say unto you, **Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, he will give it you.**

24 Hitherto have ye asked nothing in my name: **ask, and ye shall receive, that your joy may be full.**

25 These things have I spoken unto you in proverbs: but the time cometh, when I shall no more speak unto you in proverbs, but **I shall shew you plainly of the Father.** (Openly Show You the Father)

26 **At that day ye shall ask in my name**: and I say not unto you, that I will pray the Father for you:

❖ John 17:21

That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me.

❖ 1 John 3:19-22

19 Hereby we know that we are of the truth, and **shall assure our hearts before him.**

20 **For if our heart condemn us, God is greater than our heart**, and knoweth all things.

21 **Beloved, if our heart condemn us not, then have we confidence toward God.**

22 **And whatsoever we ask, we receive of him**, because we keep his commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in his sight.

➤ 1 John 4:16-18

16 **We have known and believed the love that God hath to us. God is love; and he that dwelleth in love dwelleth in God, and God in him.**

17 Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because as he is, so are we in this world.

18 **There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear...**

KINGDOM TRANSACTION BY WAY OF KNOWING THE FATHER

Matthew 6:6, 9-10

6 But thou, **when thou prayest, enter into thy closet**, and when thou hast **shut thy door, pray to thy Father which is in secret; and thy Father which seeth in secret shall reward thee openly.**

9 After this manner therefore pray ye: **Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.**

10 **Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.**

1 John 5:14-15

14 **This is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us:**

15 **And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.**

John 15:7

If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.

Mark 11:17, 22-24

17 And he taught, saying unto them, **Is it not written, My house shall be called of all nations the house of prayer?** but ye have made it a den of thieves.

22 And Jesus answering saith unto them, **Have faith in God.**

23 For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

24 Therefore I say unto you, **What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.**

WHAT DOES THE FATHER GIVE ? GRACE

Ephesians 3:2

If ye have heard of **the dispensation of the grace of God** which is given me to you-ward:

Hebrews 12:28

Wherefore **we receiving a kingdom which cannot be moved, let us have (possess) grace**, whereby we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear:

Hebrews 4:16

Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.

Act 20:32

Now, brethren, **I commend you to God, and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up, and to give you an inheritance** among all them which are sanctified.

Titus 3:7

That being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life.

Romans 6:14

For sin shall not have dominion over you: **for ye are not under the law, but under grace.**

Romans 11:6

If by grace, then is it no more of works: otherwise grace is no more grace. **But if it be of works, then is it no more grace:** otherwise work is no more work.

Romans 5:17, 20

17 For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more **they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ.**

20 Moreover the law entered, that the offence might abound. **But where sin abounded, grace did much more abound:**

Psalms 84:11

For the Lord God is a sun and shield: **the Lord will give grace and glory:** no good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly.

1 Peter 4:10

As every man hath received the gift, even so minister the same one to another, **as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.**

Acts 4:33

With great power gave the apostles witness of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus: **and great grace was upon them all.**

John 1:16

Of his fulness have all we received, and grace for grace.

Zechariah 4:6-7

6 Then he answered and spake unto me, saying, **This is the word of the LORD unto Zerubbabel, saying, Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit,** saith the LORD of hosts.

7 Who art thou, O great mountain? before Zerubbabel thou shalt become a plain: and **he shall bring forth the headstone thereof with shoutings, crying, Grace, grace unto it.**

2 Corinthians 9:8

God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work:

1 Peter 5:5-7

5 Likewise, ye younger, submit yourselves unto the elder. Yea, all of you be subject one to another, and be clothed with humility: **for God resisteth the proud, and giveth grace to the humble.**

6 **Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time:**

7 Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you.
