

The Blessing is in the Water V

Isaiah 55:1

Ho, every one that thirsteth, come ye to the waters...

John 7:37-39

37 In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink.

38 He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.

39 (But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)

Revelation 22:17

17 And the Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him that heareth say, Come. And let him that is athirst come. And whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely.

Genesis 1:1-9

1 In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

2 And the earth **was without form, and void** (empty); and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon (hovering, brooding) the face of the waters.

3 And God said, Let there be light: and there was light.

6 And God said, **Let there be a firmament** (expanse, space, canopy, atmosphere) **in the midst of the waters, and let it divide the waters from the waters.**

7 And God made the firmament, and divided the waters which were under the firmament from the waters which were above the firmament: and it was so.

8 And God called the firmament Heaven. And the evening and the morning were the second day.

9 And God said, Let the waters under the heaven be gathered together unto one place, and let the dry land appear: and it was so.

Genesis 2:4-14

4 These are the generations of the heavens and of the earth when they were created, in the day that the LORD God made the earth and the heavens,

5 And every plant of the field before it was in the earth, and every herb of the field before it grew: for the LORD God had not caused it to rain upon the earth, and there was not a man to till the ground.

6 But there went up a mist (NIV streams, NLT springs) from the earth, and watered the whole face of the ground.

7 And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.

8 And the LORD God planted a garden eastward in Eden; and there he put the man whom he had formed.

9 And out of the ground made the LORD God to grow every tree that is pleasant to the sight, and good for food; the tree of life also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of knowledge of good and evil.

10 And a river went out of Eden to water the garden; and from thence it was parted, and became into four heads.

11 The name of the first is **Pison** (increase) that is it which compasseth the whole land of Havilah, **where there is gold;**

12 And the gold of that land is good: there is bdellium and the onyx stone.

13 And the name of the second river is **Gihon** (root word bursting forth) the same is it that compasseth the whole land of Ethiopia.

14 And the name of the third river is **Hiddekel** (swift rapids) that is it which goeth toward the east of Assyria. And the fourth river is **Euphrates** (fruitfulness, abundance)

Birth of Baby

Amniotic fluid is the liquid that surrounds a baby in the womb. It plays a crucial role in a baby's development. The fluid cushions and protects the baby. The amniotic sac that contains the baby and the fluid forms about 12 days after conception. Amniotic fluid immediately begins to fill the sac. For the first 5 months amniotic fluid consists mainly of water that comes from the mother. After about 20 weeks, the baby's urine makes up most of the fluid.

John 2:1-8

- 1 And the third day there was a marriage in Cana of Galilee; and the mother of Jesus was there:
- 2 And both Jesus was called, and his disciples, to the marriage.
- 3 And when they wanted wine, the mother of Jesus saith unto him, They have no wine.
- 4 Jesus saith unto her, Woman, what have I to do with thee? mine hour is not yet come.
- 5 His mother saith unto the servants, Whatsoever he saith unto you, do it.
- 6 And there were set there **six waterpots of stone**, after the manner of the purifying of the Jews, containing two or three firkins apiece.
- 7 Jesus saith unto them, **Fill the waterpots with water. And they filled them up to the brim.**
- 8 And he saith unto them, **Draw out now, and bear unto the governor of the feast.** And they bare it.

Ezekiel 47:1-6 NIV

- 1 The man (guide) brought me back to the entrance of the temple, and I saw water coming out from under the threshold of the temple toward the east (for the temple faced east). The water was coming down from under the south side of the temple, south of the altar.
- 2 He then brought me out through the north gate and **led me around the outside** to the outer gate facing east, and the water was flowing from the south side.
- 3 As the man went eastward with a measuring line in his hand, he measured off a thousand cubits and **then led me through water that was ankle-deep.**
- 4 He measured off another thousand cubits and **led me through water that was knee-deep.** He measured off another thousand and **led me through water that was up to the waist.**
- 5 He measured off another thousand, but now it was a river that I could not cross, because **the water had risen and was deep enough to swim in**—a river that no one could cross.
- 6 He asked me, “Son of man, do you see this?” **Then he led me back to the bank of the river**

Ezekiel 47:8-10

- 8 Then said he unto me, **These waters issue out toward the east country, and go down into the desert, and go into the sea:** which being brought forth into the sea, **the waters shall be healed.**
- 9 And it shall come to pass, **that everything that liveth, which moveth, whithersoever the rivers (two rivers – double waters) shall come, shall live;** and there shall be a **very great multitude of fish**, because these waters shall come thither: **for they shall be healed; and everything shall live whither the river cometh.**
- 10 And it shall come to pass, that the fishers shall stand upon it from Engedi even unto Eneglaim; **they shall be a place to spread forth nets; their fish shall be according to their kinds, as the fish of the great sea, exceeding many.**

Ezekiel 47:12 AMP

- 12 And on the banks of the river on both its side, **shall grow all kinds of trees for food, their leaf shall not fade, nor shall their fruit fail** (to meet the demand): **each tree shall bring forth new fruit every month**, (these supernatural qualities being) **because their waters came from out of the sanctuary:** and the fruit thereof shall be for food, and their leaves for healing.

Matthew 3:13-17

- 13 Then cometh Jesus from Galilee to Jordan unto John, to be baptized of him.
- 14 But John forbad him, saying, I have need to be baptized of thee, and comest thou to me?
- 15 And Jesus answering said unto him, Suffer it to be so now: for thus it becometh us to fulfil all righteousness. Then he suffered him.
- 16 And **Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him:**
- 17 And lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.

Luke 6:17-19 (Luke 3:21 Now when all the people were baptized, it came to pass, that Jesus also being baptized...)

- 17 And he came down with them, and stood in the plain, and the company of his disciples, and a great multitude of people out of all Judaea and Jerusalem, and from the sea coast of Tyre and Sidon, which came to hear him, and to be healed of their diseases;
- 18 And they that were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed.
- 19 And the whole multitude sought to touch him: **for there went virtue out of him, and healed them all.**

❖ Gills Commentary – “for there went virtue out of him”; in great abundance, **as water from a fountain;**
