

# The Three Fold Apostolic Witness I

## THE EYEWITNESS

### Acts 1:1-3

- 1 The former treatise have I made, O Theophilus, of all that Jesus began both to do and teach,
- 2 Until the day in which he was taken up, after that he through the Holy Ghost had given commandments unto the apostles whom he had chosen:
- 3 To whom also he shewed himself alive after his passion by many infallible proofs, being seen of them forty days, and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God:

#### ❖ Luke 24:36-43

- 36 And as they thus spake, Jesus himself stood in the midst of them, and saith unto them, Peace be unto you.
- 37 But they were terrified and affrighted, and supposed that they had seen a spirit.
- 38 And he said unto them, Why are ye troubled? and why do thoughts arise in your hearts?
- 39 Behold my hands and my feet, that it is I myself: handle me, and see; for a spirit hath not flesh and bones, as ye see me have.
- 40 And when he had thus spoken, he shewed them his hands and his feet.
- 41 And while they yet believed not for joy, and wondered, he said unto them, Have ye here any meat?
- 42 And they gave him a piece of a broiled fish, and of an honeycomb.
- 43 And he took it, and did eat before them.

## THE WITNESS OF THE PSALMS

### Acts 1:3

To whom also he shewed himself alive after his passion by many infallible proofs, being seen of them forty days, and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God:

#### ❖ Luke 24:44-46

- 44 And he said unto them, These are the words which I spake unto you, while I was yet with you, that all things must be fulfilled, which were written in the law of Moses, and in the prophets, and in the psalms, concerning me.
- 45 Then opened he their understanding, that they might understand the scriptures,
- 46 And said unto them, Thus it is written, and thus it behooved Christ to suffer, and to rise from the dead the third day:

#### ❖ Acts 2:25-28, 31-35 Peter Preaches Directly from Ps 16 and Ps 110

- 25 For David speaketh concerning him, I foresaw the Lord always before my face, for he is on my right hand, that I should not be moved:
- 26 Therefore did my heart rejoice, and my tongue was glad; moreover also my flesh shall rest in hope:
- 27 Because thou wilt not leave my soul in hell, neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption.
- 28 Thou hast made known to me the ways of life; thou shalt make me full of joy with thy countenance.
- 31 He seeing this before spake of the resurrection of Christ, that his soul was not left in hell, neither his flesh did see corruption.
- 32 This Jesus hath God raised up, whereof we all are witnesses.
- 33 Therefore being by the right hand of God exalted, and having received of the Father the promise of the Holy Ghost, he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear.
- 34 For David is not ascended into the heavens: but he saith himself, The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand,
- 35 Until I make thy foes thy footstool.

## THE PROMISE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT AND POWER

### Acts 1: 4, 8-9

4 And, being assembled together with them, commanded them that **they should not depart from Jerusalem, but wait for the promise of the Father, which, saith he, ye have heard of me.**

8 **But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me** both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

9 And when he had spoken these things, while they beheld, he was taken up; and a cloud received him out of their sight.

### Luke 24: 46-51

46 And said unto them, Thus it is written, and thus it behooved Christ to suffer, and to rise from the dead the third day:

47 And that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in his name among all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.

48 And **ye are witnesses of these things.**

49 And, **behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry (wait) ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high.**

50 And he led them out as far as to Bethany, and he lifted up his hands, and blessed them.

51 And it came to pass, while he blessed them, he was parted from them, and carried up into heaven.

- ❖ **Jesus Promises them that He will send the Holy Ghost and Power**
- ❖ **Jesus commands them to wait until the Holy Spirit comes with Power**
- ❖ **Jesus Appoints them as Eyewitnesses of His Resurrection**

### John 15:26-27

26 But when the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the Spirit of truth, which proceedeth from the Father, **he shall testify of me:**

27 And **ye also shall bear witness,** because ye have been with me from the beginning.

- ❖ **Testify / Witness:** G3140 martureō (mar-too-reh'-o) - to be a witness, that is, testify. To give evidence.  
Thayer Definition: to affirm that one has seen or heard or experienced something.

### Acts 5:30-32

30 The God of our fathers raised up Jesus, whom ye slew and hanged on a tree.

31 Him hath God exalted with his right hand to be a Prince and a Saviour, for to give repentance to Israel, and forgiveness of sins.

32 And **we are his witnesses of these things; and so is also the Holy Ghost,** whom God hath given to them that obey him.

- ❖ **Witnesses:** G3144 martus (mar'-toos) - a witness literally (**judicially**) or figuratively.  
Thayer Definition: a witness in a legal sense

In the scriptures above, we see that the early church was given the Corporate Eyewitness first, then secondly Christ opened the scriptures to them and finally commanded them to wait upon the Promise and Power of the Holy Spirit.

Since God is restoring everything in reverse since the times of reformation with Martin Luther, the last office to be fully restored is the that of the Apostle. Included within this restoration will be both the doctrine of the resurrection and Right Hand of God, as well as the corporate eyewitness. We are not waiting upon the Holy Spirit, as he has already been restored since the times of the Azusa Street Revival. Moreover, for the last three years, the Holy Spirit has actively been restoring the revelations of the Resurrection and Right Hand of God, as I can personally attest to having posted over 175 messages on our Right Hand of God section of our website. Since God is restoring everything in to be reverse, The final testimony to be restored is the Apostolic Office is the Corporate Eyewitness.
