

## The Waters of Global Evangelism

John 7:37-39

37 In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink.

38 He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.

39 (But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)

❖ Acts 2:33

Therefore being by the right hand of God exalted, and having received of the Father the promise of the Holy Ghost, he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear.

❖ John 16:14-15

14 He will honor and glorify Me, because He will take of (receive, draw upon) what is Mine and will reveal (declare, disclose, transmit) it to you.

15 Everything that the Father has is Mine. That is what I meant when I said that He [the Spirit] will take the things that are Mine and will reveal (declare, disclose, transmit) it to you.

Daniel 7:13-14

13 I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him.

14 And there was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed.

Psalms 2:6-8

6 Yet have I set my king upon my holy hill of Zion.

7 I will declare the decree: the LORD hath said unto me, Thou art my Son; this day have I begotten thee.

8 Ask of me, and I shall give thee the heathen for thine inheritance, and the uttermost parts of the earth for thy possession.

❖ Acts 13:33-35

33 God hath fulfilled the same unto us their children, in that he hath raised up Jesus again; as it is also written in the second psalm, Thou art my Son, this day have I begotten thee.

34 And as concerning that he raised him up from the dead, now no more to return to corruption, he said on this wise, I will give you the sure mercies of David.

35 Wherefore he saith also in another psalm, Thou shalt not suffer thine Holy One to see corruption.

❖ Psalms 16:10-11

10 For thou wilt not leave my soul in hell; neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption.

11 Thou wilt shew me the path of life: in thy presence is fulness of joy; at thy right hand there are pleasures for evermore.

Ezekiel 47:1, 8-10

1 Afterward he brought me again unto the door of the house; and, behold, **waters issued out from under the threshold of the house** eastward: for the forefront of the house stood toward the east, and the **waters came down from under from the right side of the house, at the south side of the altar.**

8 Then said he unto me, These waters issue out toward the east country, and go down into the desert, and go into the sea: which being brought forth into the sea, the waters shall be healed.

9 And it shall come to pass, that everything that liveth, which moveth, whithersoever the rivers shall come, shall live: and **there shall be a very great multitude of fish, because these waters shall come thither:** for they shall be healed; and everything shall live whither the river cometh.

10 And it shall come to pass, that **the fishers shall stand upon it from Engedi even unto Eneglaim; they shall be a place to spread forth nets; their fish shall be according to their kinds, as the fish of the great sea, exceeding many.**

Joel 3:18

18 It shall come to pass in that day, that the mountains shall drop down new wine, and the hills shall flow with milk, and all the rivers of Judah shall flow with waters, and **a fountain shall come forth of the house of the LORD...** ( NLT - A Fountain will burst forth from the Lord's Temple)

Acts 2: 41, 47

41 Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and **the same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls.**

47 Praising God, and having favour with all the people. **And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved.**

Acts 4:2-4

2 Being grieved that they taught the people, and **preached through Jesus the resurrection from the dead.**

3 And they laid hands on them, and put them in hold unto the next day: for it was now eventide.

4 Howbeit many of them which heard the word believed; **and the number of the men was about five thousand.**

Acts 5:14-16

14 And **believers were the more added to the Lord, multitudes both of men and women.**

15 Insomuch that they brought forth the sick into the streets, and laid them on beds and couches, that at the least the shadow of Peter passing by might overshadow some of them.

16 There came also a multitude out of the cities round about unto Jerusalem, bringing sick folks, and them which were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed every one.

Acts 6:7

And the word of God increased; and **the number of the disciples multiplied in Jerusalem greatly;** and a great company of the priests were obedient to the faith.

Acts 17:6

6 And when they found them not, they drew Jason and certain brethren unto the rulers of the city, crying, **These that have turned the world upside down are come hither also;**
