

Unlocking the Inheritance Within VII

Hebrews 1:1-3

1 God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets,
2 Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom **he hath appointed heir of all things**, by whom also he made the worlds;

Psalms 2:6-8

6 **Yet have I set my king upon my holy hill of Zion.**

7 I will declare the decree: the LORD hath said unto me, Thou art my Son; this day have I begotten thee.

8 **Ask of me, and I shall give thee the heathen for thine inheritance, and the uttermost parts of the earth for thy possession.**

❖ Acts 13:33

God hath fulfilled the same unto us their children, in that he hath raised up Jesus again; as it is also **written in the second psalm, Thou art my Son, this day have I begotten thee.**

Isaiah 65:9

And I will bring forth a seed out of Jacob, and **out of Judah an inheritor of my mountains**: (Mt Hebron) and mine elect shall inherit it, and my servants shall dwell there.

Genesis 22:16-18 Abraham

16 And said, By myself have I sworn, saith the LORD, for because thou hast done this thing, and hast not withheld thy son, thine only son:

17 That in blessing I will bless thee, and **in multiplying I will multiply thy seed as the stars of the heaven, and as the sand which is upon the sea shore**; and thy seed shall possess the gate of his enemies;

18 And in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed; because thou hast obeyed my voice.

Joshua 15:13-14

13 And unto Caleb the son of Jephunneh he gave a part among the children of Judah, according to the commandment of the LORD to Joshua, even the city of Arba the father of Anak, which **city is Hebron**.

14 And **Caleb drove thence the three sons of Anak**, Sheshai, and Ahiman, and Talmi, the children of Anak.

❖ **Judges 1:20** They gave Hebron unto **Caleb**, as Moses said: and **he expelled thence the three sons of Anak**.

❖ Joshua 11:21-23

21 And **at that time came Joshua, and cut off the Anakims from the mountains, from Hebron**, from Debir, from Anab, and from all the mountains of Judah, and from all the mountains of Israel: Joshua destroyed them utterly with their cities.

22 There was none of the Anakims left in the land of the children of Israel: **only in Gaza, in Gath, and in Ashdod, there remained**.

23 So Joshua took the whole land, according to all that the LORD said unto Moses; and Joshua gave it for an inheritance unto Israel according to their divisions by their tribes. And the land rested from war.

❖ 1 Samuel 17:4

And there went out a champion out of the camp of the Philistines, **named Goliath, of Gath**, whose height was six cubits and a span.

1 Samuel 30:9-10

9 So **David went, he and the six hundred men that were with him**, and came to the brook Besor, where those that were left behind stayed.

10 But **David pursued, he and four hundred men: for two hundred abode behind**, which were so faint that they could not go over the brook Besor.

2 Samuel 2:1-4

- 1 And it came to pass after this, that **David enquired of the LORD**, saying, Shall I go up into any of the cities of Judah? And the LORD said unto him, Go up. And **David said, Whither shall I go up? And he said, Unto Hebron.**
- 2 So David went up thither, and his two wives also, Ahinoam the Jezreelitess, and Abigail Nabal's wife the Carmelite.
- 3 And his men that were with him did David bring up, every man with his household: and they dwelt in the cities of Hebron.
- 4 And **the men of Judah came, and there they anointed David king over the house of Judah...**

2 Samuel 5:1-5

- 1 **Then came all the tribes of Israel to David unto Hebron**, and spake, saying, Behold, we are thy bone and thy flesh.
- 2 Also in time past, when Saul was king over us, thou wast he that leddest out and broughtest in Israel: and the LORD said to thee, Thou shalt feed my people Israel, and thou shalt be a captain over Israel.
- 3 **So all the elders of Israel came to the king to Hebron**; and king David made a league with them in Hebron before the LORD: and **they anointed David king over Israel.**
- 4 David was thirty years old when he began to reign, and he reigned forty years.
- 5 **In Hebron he reigned over Judah seven years and six months**: and in Jerusalem he reigned thirty and three years over all Israel and Judah.

1 Chronicles 12:23-38

- 23 And **these are the numbers of the bands that were ready armed to the war, and came to David to Hebron, to turn the kingdom of Saul to him, according to the word of the LORD.**
- 24 The children of **Judah** that bare shield and spear were six thousand and eight hundred **(6,800)**, ready armed to the war.
- 25 Of the children of **Simeon**, mighty men of valour for the war, seven thousand and one hundred. **(7,100)**
- 26 Of the children of **Levi** four thousand and six hundred. **(4,600)**
- 27 And **Jehoiada was the leader of the Aaronites**, and with him were **three thousand and seven hundred; (3700)**
- 28 And **Zadok**, a young man mighty of valour, and of his father's house **twenty and two captains. (22 Captains)**
- 29 And of the children of **Benjamin**, the kindred of Saul, **three thousand: (3000)** for hitherto the greatest part of them had kept the ward of the house of Saul.
- 30 And of the children of **Ephraim** **twenty thousand and eight hundred, (28,000)** mighty men of valour, famous throughout the house of their fathers.
- 31 And of the **half tribe of Manasseh** **eighteen thousand, (18,000)** which were expressed by name, to come and make David king.
- 32 And of the children of **Issachar**, which were men that had understanding of the times, to know what Israel ought to do; **the heads of them were two hundred; (200)** and all their brethren were at their commandment.
- 33 Of **Zebulun**, such as went forth to battle, expert in war, with all instruments of war, **fifty thousand, which could keep rank: they were not of double heart. (50,000)**
- 34 And of **Naphtali** a **thousand captains, (1000 captains)** and with them with shield and spear **thirty and seven thousand. (37,000)**
- 35 And of the **Danites** expert in war **twenty and eight thousand and six hundred. (28,600)**
- 36 And of **Asher**, such as went forth to battle, **expert in war, forty thousand. (40,000)**
- 37 And on the other side of Jordan, of the **Reubenites, and the Gadites, and of the half tribe of Manasseh**, with all manner of instruments of war for the battle, an hundred and twenty thousand. **(120,000)**
- 38 **All these men of war, that could keep rank, came with a perfect heart to Hebron, to make David king over all Israel: and all the rest also of Israel were of one heart to make David king.**

❖ **348,800 men, and upwards.**

1 Chronicles 29:27-28

- 27 And the time that he reigned over Israel was forty years; **seven years reigned he in Hebron, and thirty and three years reigned he in Jerusalem.**
- 28 **And he died in a good old age, full of days, riches, and honour: and Solomon his son reigned in his stead.**
