

COMMISSIONED FROM ABOVE - CHRIST

Hebrews 3:1

Wherefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the **Apostle and High Priest of our profession, Christ Jesus;**

Luke 2:41-52

41 Now his parents went to Jerusalem every year at the feast of the passover.

42 And **when he was twelve years old, they went up to Jerusalem** after the custom of the feast.

46 And it came to pass, that after three days **they found him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the doctors, both hearing them, and asking them questions.**

47 **And all that heard him were astonished at his understanding and answers.**

48 And when they saw him, they were amazed: and his mother said unto him, Son, why hast thou thus dealt with us? behold, thy father and I have sought thee sorrowing.

49 And he said unto them, **How is it that ye sought me? wist ye not that I must be about my Father's business?**

50 And they understood not the saying which he spake unto them.

51 **And he went down with them, and came to Nazareth, and was subject unto them:** but his mother kept all these sayings in her heart.

52 And **Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favour with God and man.**

CHRIST THE SON - ORDAINED & APPOINTED HEIR OF ALL THINGS

Hebrews 1:2

1 God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets,
2 Hath in these last days **spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things,** by whom also he made the worlds;

Matthew 3:13-17

16 And Jesus, when **he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him:**

17 And **lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.**

Matthew 17:1-5, 9

1 And after six days Jesus taketh Peter, James, and John his brother, and **bringeth them up into an high mountain apart,**

2 **And was transfigured before them: and his face did shine as the sun, and his raiment was white as the light.**

3 And, behold, there appeared unto them Moses and Elias talking with him.

4 Then answered Peter, and said unto Jesus, Lord, it is good for us to be here: if thou wilt, let us make here three tabernacles; one for thee, and one for Moses, and one for Elias.

5 While he yet spake, behold, **a bright cloud overshadowed them: and behold a voice out of the cloud, which said, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear ye him.**

9 And as they came down from the mountain, Jesus charged them, saying, **Tell the vision to no man, until the Son of man be risen again from the dead.**

❖ 2 Peter 1:16-18

16 For we have not followed cunningly devised fables, when we made known unto you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, **but were eyewitnesses of his majesty.**

17 For he received from God the Father honour and glory, when **there came such a voice to him from the excellent glory, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.**

18 **This voice which came from heaven we heard,** when we were with him in the holy mount.

CHRIST THE APOSTLE - SENT FROM THE FATHER, DOCTRINE & EYEWITNESS OF THE FATHER

John 7:16, 28-29

16 Jesus answered them, and said, **My doctrine is not mine, but his that sent me.**

28 Then cried Jesus in the temple as he taught, saying, Ye both know me, and ye know whence I am: and **I am not come of myself,** but he that sent me is true, whom ye know not.

29 But I know him: for **I am from him, and he hath sent me.**

John 6:45-46

45 It is written in the prophets, And they shall be all taught of God. Every man therefore that hath heard, and hath learned of the Father, cometh unto me.

46 **Not that any man hath seen the Father, save he which is of God, he hath seen the Father.**

John 8:37-38

37 I know that ye are Abraham's seed; but ye seek to kill me, because my word hath no place in you.

38 **I speak that which I have seen with my Father:** and ye do that which ye have seen with your father.

WHO WILL GO FOR US

Isaiah 6:1-8

1 In the year that king Uzziah died **I saw also the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up, and his train filled the temple.**

2 Above it stood the seraphims: each one had six wings; with twain he covered his face, and with twain he covered his feet, and with twain he did fly.

3 And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, is the LORD of hosts: the whole earth is full of his glory.

4 And the posts of the door moved at the voice of him that cried, and the house was filled with smoke.

5 **Then said I, Woe is me! for I am undone; because I am a man of unclean lips,** and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips: **for mine eyes have seen the King, the Lord of hosts.**

6 Then flew one of the seraphims unto me, having a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with the tongs from off the altar:

7 And he laid it upon my mouth, and said, Lo, this hath touched thy lips; and thine iniquity is taken away, and thy sin purged.

8 **Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, Whom shall I send, and who will go for us? Then said I, Here am I; send me.**

9 And he said, Go, and tell this people, Hear ye indeed, but understand not; and see ye indeed, but perceive not.

CHRIST - APPROVED OF GOD AND ANOINTED WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT & POWER

Acts 2:22

Ye men of Israel, hear these words; Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of God among you by miracles and wonders and signs, which God did by him in the midst of you...

Acts 10:37-38

37 That word, I say, ye know, which was published throughout all Judaea, and began from Galilee, after the baptism which John preached;

38 How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

Luke 4:14-19

14 And Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit into Galilee: and there went out a fame of him through all the region round about.

17 And there was delivered unto him the book of the prophet Esaias. And when he had opened the book, he found the place where it was written,

18 The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised,

19 To preach the acceptable year of the Lord.

John 10:36-38

36 Say ye of him, whom the Father hath sanctified, and sent into the world, Thou blasphemest; because I said, I am the Son of God?

37 If I do not the works of my Father, believe me not.

38 But if I do, though ye believe not me, believe the works: that ye may know, and believe, that the Father is in me, and I in him.

John 14:10-11

10 Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works.

11 Believe me that I am in the Father, and the Father in me: or else believe me for the very works' sake.

John 5:36

I have greater witness than that of John: for the works which the Father hath given me to finish, the same works that I do, bear witness of me, that the Father hath sent me.

John 2:23

Now when he was in Jerusalem at the passover, in the feast day, many believed in his name, when they saw the miracles which he did.

John 6:2

A great multitude followed him, because they saw his miracles which he did on them that were diseased.

John 3:1-2

1 There was a man of the Pharisees, named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews:

2 The same came to Jesus by night, and said unto him, **Rabbi, we know that thou art a teacher come from God: for no man can do these miracles that thou doest, except God be with him.**

John 11:47-48

47 Then gathered the chief priests and the Pharisees a council, and said, **What do we? for this man doeth many miracles.**

48 **If we let him thus alone, all men will believe on him:** and **the Romans shall come and take away both our place and nation.**
