

KINGDOM TRANSFERENCE - THE OVERSHADOWING

Matthew 6:6, 9-11

6 But thou, when thou prayest, enter into thy closet, and when thou hast shut thy door, pray to thy Father which is in secret; and thy Father which seeth in secret shall reward thee openly.

9 After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.

10 **Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.**

11 Give us this day our daily bread.

Hebrews 1:2-3

2 Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, **whom he hath appointed heir of all things**, by whom also he made the worlds;

3 Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, **sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;**

❖ Matthew 28:18

Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.

❖ Daniel 7:13-14

13 I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him.

14 And there was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: his dominion is an everlasting dominion...

❖ Revelation 5:12

Saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing.

❖ Psalms 2:6-8

6 Yet have I set my king upon my holy hill of Zion.

7 I will declare the decree: the Lord hath said unto me, Thou art my Son; this day have I begotten thee.

8 Ask of me, and I shall give thee the heathen (nations) for thine inheritance, and the uttermost parts of the earth for thy possession.

❖ Ephesians 1:3

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ:

❖ Isaiah 65:9

I will bring forth a seed out of Jacob, and out of Judah an inheritor of my mountains: (Mt Hebron) and mine elect shall inherit it, and my servants shall dwell there.

John 16:13-15

13 Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, **he will guide you into all truth**: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and **he will shew you things to come**.

14 **He shall glorify me**: for **he shall receive of mine, and shall show** (AMP - declare, disclose, transmit) **it unto you**.

15 **All things that the Father hath are mine**: therefore said I, that he shall take of mine, and shall **show** (AMP - declare, disclose, transmit) **it unto you**.

❖ Mark 11:22, 24

Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

❖ Colossians 1:19 For it pleased the Father that in him should all fulness dwell;

❖ John 1:16 Of his fulness have all we received, and grace for grace.

Acts 6:3, 8, 10, 15

3 Wherefore, brethren, look ye out among you seven men of honest report, **full of the Holy Ghost and wisdom**, whom we may appoint over this business.

8 And **Stephen, full of faith and power, did great wonders and miracles among the people**.

10 And they were not able to resist **the wisdom and the spirit by which he spake**.

15 **All that sat in the council, looking stedfastly on him, saw his face as it had been the face of an angel**.

Acts 3:6

Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; **but such as I have give I thee: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk**.

Acts 5:14-16

14 And believers were the more added to the Lord, multitudes both of men and women.

15 Insomuch that they brought forth the sick into the streets, and laid them on beds and couches, that at the least **the shadow (Glory) of Peter passing by might overshadow some of them**.

16 There came also a multitude out of the cities round about unto Jerusalem, bringing sick folks, and them which were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed every one.

Acts 13:8-12

9 **Then Saul, (who also is called Paul,) filled with the Holy Ghost, set his eyes on him,**

10 And said, O full of all subtilty and all mischief, thou child of the devil, thou enemy of all righteousness, wilt thou not cease to pervert the right ways of the Lord?

11 And now, behold, **the hand of the Lord is upon thee, and thou shalt be blind, not seeing the sun for a season**. And immediately there fell on him a mist and a darkness; and he went about seeking some to lead him by the hand.

12 **Then the deputy, when he saw what was done, believed, being astonished at the doctrine of the Lord**.

Exodus 40:33-35

33 ... So Moses finished the work.

34 **Then a cloud covered the tent of the congregation, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle.**

1 Kings 8:10-13

10 And it came to pass, when the priests were come out of the holy place, **that the cloud filled the house of the LORD,**

11 So that the priests could not stand to minister because of the cloud: **for the glory of the LORD had filled the house of the LORD.**

12 Then spake Solomon, The LORD said that he would dwell in the thick darkness.

13 **I have surely built thee an house to dwell in, a settled place for thee to abide in forever.**

Luke 17:5-10

5 **The apostles said unto the Lord, Increase our faith.**

6 And the Lord said, If ye had faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye might say unto this sycamine tree, Be thou plucked up by the root, and be thou planted in the sea; and it should obey you.

7 **But which of you, having a servant plowing or feeding cattle, will say unto him by and by, when he is come from the field, Go and sit down to meat?**

8 **And will not rather say unto him, Make ready wherewith I may sup, and gird thyself, and serve me, till I have eaten and drunken; and afterward thou shalt eat and drink?**

9 Doth he thank that servant because he did the things that were commanded him? I trow not.

10 So likewise ye, when ye shall have done all those things which are commanded you, say, We are unprofitable servants: we have done that which was our duty to do.

❖ John 6:8-13

8 One of his disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, saith unto him,

9 There is a lad here, which hath five barley loaves, and two small fishes: but what are they among so many?

10 And Jesus said, Make the men sit down. Now there was much grass in the place. So the men sat down, in number about five thousand.

11 And **Jesus took the loaves; and when he had given thanks, he distributed to the disciples,** and the disciples to them that were set down; and likewise of the fishes as much as they would.

12 When they were filled, he said unto his disciples, Gather up the fragments that remain, that nothing be lost.

13 **Therefore they gathered them together, and filled twelve baskets with the fragments of the five barley loaves, which remained over and above unto them that had eaten.**
