

LIVING WATERS SCRIPTURES

Jeremiah 2:13

For my people have committed two evils; they have forsaken me the fountain of living waters, and hewed them out cisterns, broken cisterns, that can hold no water.

Revelation 22:1

He shewed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb.

Revelation 21:6

He said unto me, It is done. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give unto him that is athirst of the fountain of the water of life freely.

Revelation 22:17

The Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him that heareth say, Come. And let him that is athirst come. And whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely.

John 4:14 AMP

Whoever takes a drink of the water that I will give him shall never, no never, be thirsty any more. But the water that I will give him shall become a spring of water welling up flowing, bubbling up continually within him unto (into, for) eternal life.

John 7:37-39

37 In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink.

38 He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.

39 (But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)

Psalms 36:7-9

7 How excellent is thy lovingkindness, O God! therefore the children of men put their trust under the shadow of thy wings.

8 They shall be abundantly satisfied with the fatness of thy house; and thou shalt make them drink of the river of thy pleasures. (Eden)

9 For with thee is the fountain of life: in thy light shall we see light.

Isaiah 55:1

Ho, every one that thirsteth, come ye to the waters...

1 Corinthians 10:4

They all did drink of the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that Rock was Christ.

Psalms 105:41

He opened the rock, and the waters gushed out; they ran in the dry places like a river.

Psalms 78:15-16

15 He clave the rocks in the wilderness, and gave them drink as out of the great depths.

16 He brought streams also out of the rock, and caused waters to run down like rivers.

Psalms 114:7-8

7 Tremble, thou earth, at the presence of the Lord, at the presence of the God of Jacob;

8 Which turned the rock into a standing water, the flint into a fountain of waters.

Numbers 20:8

... speak ye unto the rock before their eyes; and it shall give forth his water, and thou shalt bring forth to them water out of the rock: so thou shalt give the congregation and their beasts drink.

Genesis 2:10-11, 13-15

10 And a river went out of Eden to water the garden; and from thence it was parted, and became into four heads.

11 The name of the first is Pison... (Increase)

13 And the name of the second river is Gihon... (Bursting Forth)

14 And the name of the third river is Hiddekel (Rapidly)... And the fourth river is Euphrates. (Fruitfulness)

15 And the Lord God took the man, and put him into the garden of Eden to dress it and to keep it.

Isaiah 41:17-18

17 When the poor and needy seek water, and there is none, and their tongue faileth for thirst, I the Lord will hear them, I the God of Israel will not forsake them.

18 I will open rivers in high places, and fountains in the midst of the valleys: I will make the wilderness a pool of water, and the dry land springs of water.

Psalms 46:4

There is a river, the streams whereof shall make glad the city of God, the holy place of the tabernacles of the most High.

Isaiah 33:16 ISV

This is the one who will live on the heights; his refuge will be a mountain fortress. His food will be supplied, and **his water will be guaranteed.**

Isaiah 58:11

The Lord shall guide thee continually, and satisfy thy soul in drought, and make fat thy bones: and **thou shalt be like a watered garden, and like a spring of water, whose waters fail not.**

Jeremiah 31:12,14

12 Therefore they shall come and sing in the height of Zion, and shall flow together to the goodness of the Lord, for wheat, and for wine, and for oil, and for the young of the flock and of the herd: and **their soul shall be as a watered garden; and they shall not sorrow any more at all.**

14 **I will satiate the soul of the priests with fatness, and my people shall be satisfied with my goodness,** saith the Lord.

Isaiah 44:3

I will pour water upon him that is thirsty, and floods upon the dry ground: I will pour my spirit upon thy seed, and my blessing upon thine offspring:

Psalms 65:9-11

9 **Thou visitest the earth, and waterest it: thou greatly enrichest it with the river of God, which is full of water:** thou preparest corn, when thou hast so provided for it.

10 **Thou waterest the ridges thereof abundantly: thou settlest the furrows thereof: thou makest it soft with showers: thou blessest the springing thereof.**

11 Thou crownest the year with thy goodness; and thy paths drop fatness.

Proverbs 4:23

Keep thy heart with all diligence; **for out of it are the issues of life.** (wellsprings)

Isaiah 66:12 ISV

This is what the Lord says: **"See, I will extend prosperity to her like a river, and the wealth of nations like a flooding stream;** and you will nurse, and you will be carried on her hip, and bounced upon her knees.

Ezekiel 47:1-5, 8-12 AMP

1 The He brought me again to the door of the house of the Lord (the temple), and behold, waters issued out from under the threshold of the temple toward the east, for the front of the temple was toward the east; and the waters came down from under, from the right side of the temple, on the south side of the altar.

2 Then he brought me out by way of the north gate and led me around outside to the outer gate by the way that faces east, and behold, waters were running out on the right side.

3 And when the man went on eastward with the measuring line in his hand, he measured a thousand cubits, and he caused me to pass through the waters, waters that were ankle-deep.

4 Again he measured a thousand cubits and caused me to pass through the waters, waters that reached to the knees. Again he measured a thousand cubits and caused me to pass through the waters, waters that reached to the loins.

5 Afterward he measured a thousand, and it was a river that I could not pass through, for the waters had risen, waters to swim in, a river that could not be passed over or through.

8 Then he said to me, These waters pour out toward the eastern region and go down into the Arabah (the Jordan Valley) and on into the Dead Sea. When they shall enter into the sea (the sea of putrid waters), the waters shall be healed and made fresh.

9 And wherever the double river shall go, every living creature which swarms shall live. And there shall be a very great number of fish, because these waters go there that [the waters of the sea] may be healed and made fresh; and everything shall live wherever the river goes.

10 The fishermen shall stand on (the banks of the Dead Sea); from En-ge-di even to En-eglaim shall be a place to spread nets; their fish shall be of very many kinds, as the fish of the Great or Mediterranean Sea.

11 But its swamps and marshes will not become wholesome for animal life; they shall (as the river subsides) be left encrusted with salt and given over to it.

12 And on the banks of the river on both its sides, there shall grow all kinds of trees for food; their leaf shall not fade nor shall their fruit fail (to meet the demand). Each tree shall bring forth new fruit every month, [these supernatural qualities being] because their waters came from out of the sanctuary. And their fruit shall be for food and their leaves for healing.

Zechariah 14:8 AMP

It shall come to pass in that day that living waters shall go out from Jerusalem; half of them toward the eastern sea (Dead Sea) and half of them to the western sea (Mediterranean Sea): in summer and in winter shall it be.

Joel 3:18

It shall come to pass in that day, that the mountains shall drop down new wine, and the hills shall flow with milk, and all the rivers of Judah shall flow with waters, and **a fountain shall come forth of the house of the Lord,** (NLT - A Fountain will burst forth from the Lord's Temple) and shall water the valley of Shittim.

Isaiah 35:1-2, 5-7

1 **The wilderness and the solitary place shall be glad for them; and the desert shall rejoice, and blossom as the rose.**

2 It shall blossom abundantly, and rejoice even with joy and singing: the glory of Lebanon shall be given unto it, the excellency of Carmel and Sharon, they shall see the Glory of the Lord, and the excellency of our God.

5 Then **the eyes of the blind shall be opened,** and **the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped.**

6 Then shall **the lame man leap as an hart,** and **the tongue of the dumb sing: for in the wilderness shall waters break out, and streams in the desert.**

7 And **the parched ground shall become a pool, and the thirsty land springs of water...**

Psalms 107:23-24, 35-38

23 **They that go down to the sea in ships, that do business in great waters;**

24 **These see the works of the Lord, and his wonders in the deep.**

35 **He turneth the wilderness into a standing water,** and **dry ground into watersprings.**

36 And there he maketh the hungry to dwell, that they **may prepare a city for habitation;**

37 And sow the fields, and plant vineyards, which may yield fruits of increase.

38 He blesseth them also, so that **they are multiplied greatly;** and suffereth not their cattle to decrease.

Isaiah 43:19-20

19 Behold, I will do a new thing; now it shall spring forth; shall ye not know it? I will even make a way in the wilderness, **and rivers in the desert.**

20 The beast of the field shall honour me, the dragons and the owls: because **I give waters in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert, to give drink to my people, my chosen.**

Psalms 42:7

Deep calleth unto deep at the noise of thy waterspouts...

Deuteronomy 8:7

For the Lord thy God bringeth thee into a good land, a land of brooks of water, of fountains and depths that spring out of valleys and hills;

John 2:5-11

5 His mother saith unto the servants, Whatsoever he saith unto you, do it.

6 And there were set there six waterpots of stone, after the manner of the purifying of the Jews, containing two or three firkins apiece.

7 Jesus saith unto them, Fill the waterpots with water. And they filled them up to the brim.

8 And he saith unto them, Draw out now, and bear unto the governor of the feast. And they bare it.

9 When the ruler of the feast had tasted the water that was made wine, and knew not whence it was: (but the servants which drew the water knew;) the governor of the feast called the bridegroom,

10 And saith unto him, Every man at the beginning doth set forth good wine; and when men have well drunk, then that which is worse: but thou hast kept the good wine until now.

11 This beginning of miracles did Jesus in Cana of Galilee, and manifested forth his glory; and his disciples believed on him.

Luke 6:19

The whole multitude sought to touch him: for there went virtue out of him, and healed them all.

Ephesians 5:26-27

26 That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word,

27 That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.

Hebrews 10:22

Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water.
