# THE MT. HEBRON INHERITANCE

Numbers 13:1-2, 6, 21-23

- 1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,
- 2 Send thou men, that they may search the land of Canaan, which I give unto the children of Israel: of every tribe of their fathers shall ye send a man, <u>everyone a ruler among them.</u>
- 6 Of the tribe of Judah, Caleb the son of Jephunneh.
- 21 So they went up, and searched the land from the wilderness of Zin unto Rehob, as men come to Hamath.
- 22 And they ascended by the south, and came unto Hebron; where Ahiman, Sheshai, and Talmai, the children of Anak, were. (Now Hebron was built seven years before Zoan in Egypt.)
- 23 And they came unto the **brook of Eshcol**, and <u>cut down from thence a branch with one cluster of grapes</u>, <u>and they bare it between two upon a staff</u>; and they brought of the pomegranates, and of the figs.

Numbers 13:27-33

- 27 And they told him, and said, We came unto the land whither thou sentest us, and surely it floweth with milk and honey; and this is the fruit of it.
- 28 <u>Nevertheless the people be strong that dwell in the land, and the cities are walled, and very great: and moreover we saw the children of Anak there.</u>
- 29 The Amalekites dwell in the land of the south: and the Hittites, and the Jebusites, and the Amorites, dwell in the mountains: and the Canaanites dwell by the sea, and by the coast of Jordan.
- 30 And <u>Caleb stilled the people before Moses</u>, and said, <u>Let us go up at once</u>, and <u>possess it</u>; for we are well able to overcome it.
- 31 But the men that went up with him said, <u>We be not able to go up against the people; for they are stronger than we.</u>
- 32 And they brought up an evil report of the land which they had searched unto the children of Israel, saying, The land, through which we have gone to search it, is a land that eateth up the inhabitants thereof; and all the people that we saw in it are men of a great stature.
- 33 And there we saw the giants, the sons of Anak, which come of the giants: and we were in our own sight as grasshoppers, and so we were in their sight.

Joshua 14:6-14

- 6 Then the children of Judah came unto Joshua in Gilgal: and <u>Caleb</u> the son of Jephunneh the Kenezite said unto him, Thou knowest the thing that the LORD said unto Moses the man of God concerning me and thee in Kadeshbarnea.
- 7 Forty years old was I when Moses the servant of the LORD sent me from Kadeshbarnea to espy out the land; and I brought him word again as it was in mine heart.
- 8 Nevertheless my brethren that went up with me made the heart of the people melt: <u>but I wholly followed</u> <u>the LORD my God.</u>
- 9 And Moses sware on that day, saying, <u>Surely the land whereon thy feet have trodden shall be thine inheritance</u>, and thy children's forever, because thou hast wholly followed the LORD my God.
- 10 And now, behold, the LORD hath kept me alive, as he said, these forty and five years, even since the LORD spake this word unto Moses, while the children of Israel wandered in the wilderness: and now, lo, I am this day fourscore and five years old.
- 11 As yet I am as strong this day as I was in the day that Moses sent me: as my strength was then, even so is my strength now, for war, both to go out, and to come in.
- 12 Now therefore give me this mountain...

## THE BLESSING OF GENERATIONAL INHERITANCE TO THE PATRIARCHS

#### THE BLESSING TO ABRAHAM

Genesis 12:1-3

- 1 Now the Lord had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee:
- 2 And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing:
- 3 And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed.

Genesis 13:16-18

- 16 And I will make thy seed as the dust of the earth: so that if a man can number the dust of the earth, then shall thy seed also be numbered.
- 17 Arise, walk through the land in the length of it and in the breadth of it; for I will give it unto thee.
- 18 Then Abram removed his tent, and came and <u>dwelt in the plain of Mamre, which is in Hebron</u>, and built there an altar unto the Lord.

Genesis 22:16-18

- 16 By myself have I sworn, saith the Lord, for because thou hast done this thing, and hast not withheld thy son, thine only son:
- 17 That in blessing I will bless thee, and in multiplying I will multiply thy seed as the stars of the heaven, and as the sand which is upon the sea shore; and thy seed shall possess the gate of his enemies;
- 18 And in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed; because thou hast obeyed my voice.

## THE BLESSING TO ISAAC

Genesis 26:4

I will make thy seed to multiply as the stars of heaven, and will give unto thy seed all these countries; and in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed;

#### THE BLESSING TO JACOB

Genesis 28:14

Thy seed shall be as the dust of the earth, and thou shalt spread abroad to the west, and to the east, and to the north, and to the south: and in the earth in thy seed shall all the families of the earth be blessed.

#### THE BLESSING SOWN INTO MT. HEBRON

Genesis 23:19

Abraham buried Sarah his wife in the cave of the field of Machpelah before Mamre: the same is Hebron in the land of Canaan.

#### Genesis 49:29-31 Jacob Gives Burial Instructions

- 29 And he charged them, and said unto them, I am to be gathered unto my people: <u>bury me with my fathers</u> in the cave that is in the field of Ephron the Hittite,
- 30 <u>In the cave that is in the field of Machpelah, which is before Mamre</u>, in the land of Canaan, which Abraham bought with the field of Ephron the Hittite for a possession of a burying place.
- 31 There they buried Abraham and Sarah his wife; there they buried Isaac and Rebekah his wife; and there I buried Leah.

- 2 Kings 13:20-21 Anointing Remains in the Bones
- 20 And Elisha died, and they buried him. And the bands of the Moabites invaded the land at the coming in of the year.
- 21 And it came to pass, as they were burying a man, that, behold, they spied a band of men; and they cast the man into the sepulchre of Elisha: and when the man was let down, and touched the bones of Elisha, he revived, and stood up on his feet.

John 12:24 The Anointing of Divine Multiplication

Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit

## **CALEB INHERITS MT. HEBRON**

Joshua 14:10-14

- 10 And now, behold, the LORD hath kept me alive, as he said, these forty and five years, even since the LORD spake this word unto Moses, while the children of Israel wandered in the wilderness: and now, lo, I am this day fourscore and five years old.
- 11 As yet I am as strong this day as I was in the day that Moses sent me: as my strength was then, even so is my strength now, for war, both to go out, and to come in.
- **12** Now therefore give me this mountain, whereof the LORD spake in that day; for thou heardest in that day how the Anakims were there, and that the cities were great and fenced: if so be the LORD will be with me, then I shall be able to drive them out, as the LORD said.
- 13 And Joshua blessed him, and gave unto Caleb the son of Jephunneh Hebron for an inheritance.
- 14 Hebron therefore became the inheritance of Caleb the son of Jephunneh the Kenezite unto this day, because that he wholly followed the LORD God of Israel.

Joshua 15:13-14

- 13 And unto <u>Caleb</u> the son of Jephunneh he gave a part among the children of Judah, according to the commandment of the LORD to Joshua, even the city of Arba the father of Anak, <u>which city is Hebron.</u>
- 14 And Caleb drove thence the three sons of Anak, Sheshai, and Ahiman, and Talmai, the children of Anak.

Joshua 21:13

Thus <u>they gave to the children of Aaron the priest Hebron with her suburbs</u>, to be a city of refuge for the slayer; and Libnah with her suburbs,
