

THE KING OF TYRE II

Ezekiel 26:2-3, 7,12

2 Son of man, because that **Tyrus hath said against Jerusalem, Aha, she is broken that was the gates of the people: she is turned unto me: I shall be replenished, now she is laid waste:**

3 Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, **I am against thee, O Tyrus, and will cause many nations to come up against thee,** as the sea causeth his waves to come up.

7 For thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, **I will bring upon Tyus Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon, a king of kings, from the north, with horses, and with chariots, and with horsemen, and companies, and much people.**

12 And **they shall make a spoil of thy riches, and make a prey of thy merchandise:** and **they shall break down thy walls,** and destroy thy pleasant houses: and **they shall lay thy stones and thy timber and thy dust in the midst of the water.** (They - Nebuchadnezzar and Alexander)

THE KING OF TYRE - "the devil himself"

Ezekiel 28:12-17

12 Son of man, take up a lamentation upon the **king of Tyrus,** and say unto him, Thus saith the Lord GOD; **Thou sealest up the sum, full of wisdom, and perfect in beauty.**

13 **Thou hast been in Eden the garden of God; every precious stone was thy covering,** the sardius, topaz, and the diamond, the beryl, the onyx, and the jasper, the sapphire, the emerald, and the carbuncle, and gold: the workmanship of thy tabrets and of thy pipes was prepared in thee in the day that thou wast created.

14 **Thou art the anointed cherub that covereth; and I have set thee so: thou wast upon the holy mountain of God; thou hast walked up and down in the midst of the stones of fire.**

15 Thou wast perfect in thy ways from the day that thou wast created, till iniquity was found in thee.

16 **By the multitude of thy merchandise they have filled the midst of thee with violence, and thou hast sinned: therefore I will cast thee as profane out of the mountain of God: and I will destroy thee, O covering cherub, from the midst of the stones of fire.**

Ezekiel 27:2-3

2 Now, thou son of man, take up a lamentation for Tyrus;

3 And **say unto Tyrus, O thou that art situate at the entry of the sea, which art a merchant of the people...** (merchant center of the world, She is a mart of nations, Merchandise mart of the world)

THE LORD WILL VISIT TYRE - PROPHECY FOR SPIRITUAL TYRE

Isaiah 23:1-3

1 **The burden of Tyre. Howl, ye ships of Tarshish; for it is laid waste, so that there is no house, no entering in:** from the land of Chittim it is revealed to them.

2 Be still, ye inhabitants of the isle; thou whom the merchants of Zidon, that pass over the sea, have replenished.

3 And by great waters the seed of Sihor, **the harvest of the river, is her revenue; and she is a mart of nations.**

Isaiah 23:8-11

8 Who hath taken this counsel against Tyre, the crowning city, whose merchants are princes, whose traffickers are the honourable of the earth?

9 The LORD of hosts hath purposed it, to stain the pride of all glory, and to bring into contempt all the honourable of the earth.

10 Pass through thy land as a river, O daughter of Tarshish: there is no more strength.

11 He stretched out his hand over the sea, he shook the kingdoms: the LORD hath given a commandment against the merchant city, to destroy the strong holds thereof.

Isaiah 23:14-18

14 Howl, ye ships of Tarshish: for your strength is laid waste.

15 And it shall come to pass in that day, that Tyre shall be forgotten seventy years, according to the days of one king: after the end of seventy years shall Tyre sing as an harlot.

16 Take an harp, go about the city, thou harlot that hast been forgotten; make sweet melody, sing many songs, that thou mayest be remembered.

17 And it shall come to pass after the end of seventy years, that the Lord will visit Tyre, and she shall turn to her hire, and shall commit fornication (financial) with all the kingdoms of the world upon the face of the earth.

18 And her merchandise and her hire shall be holiness to the Lord: it shall not be treasured nor laid up; for her merchandise shall be for them that dwell before the Lord, to eat sufficiently, and for durable clothing.

Haggai 2:6-9

6 For thus says the Lord of hosts: Once again, in a little while, I will shake the heavens and the earth and the sea and the dry land;

7 I will shake all nations, so that the treasures of all nations shall come in, and I will fill this house with splendor, says the Lord of hosts.

8 The silver is mine, and the gold is mine, says the Lord of hosts.

9 In this place will I give prosperity, saith the Lord of hosts.

Luke 4:5-8

5 And the devil, taking him up into an high mountain, shewed unto him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time.

6 And the devil said unto him, All this power will I give thee, and the glory of them: for that is delivered unto me; and to whomsoever I will I give it.

7 If thou wilt worship me, all shall be thine. (John 16:15 All things that the Father hath are mine)

8 And Jesus answered and said unto him, Get thee behind me, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.

Ezekiel 47:1-2 AMP

1 THEN HE [my guide] brought me again to the door of the house [of the Lord--the temple], and behold, waters issued out from under the threshold of the temple toward the east, for the front of the temple was toward the east; and the waters came down from under, from the right side of the temple, on the south side of the altar.

2 Then he brought me out by way of the north gate and led me around outside to the outer gate by the way that faces east, and behold, waters were running out on the right side.

Ezekiel 47:8-12 AMP

8 Then he said to me, These waters pour out toward the eastern region and go down into the Arabah (the Jordan Valley) and on into the Dead Sea. And when they shall enter into the sea [the sea of putrid waters], the waters shall be healed and made fresh.

9 And wherever the double river shall go, every living creature which swarms shall live. And there shall be a very great number of fish, because these waters go there that [the waters of the sea] may be healed and made fresh; and everything shall live wherever the river goes.

12 And on the banks of the river on both its sides, there shall grow all kinds of trees for food; their leaf shall not fade nor shall their fruit fail [to meet the demand]. Each tree shall bring forth new fruit every month, [these supernatural qualities being] because their waters came from out of the sanctuary. And their fruit shall be for food and their leaves for healing.

Zechariah 14:8 AMP

8 And it shall come to pass in that day that living waters shall go out from Jerusalem; half of them toward the eastern sea (Dead Sea) and half of them to the western sea (Mediterranean Sea); in summer and in winter shall it be.

Joel 3:18

18 It shall come to pass in that day, that the mountains shall drop down new wine, and the hills shall flow with milk, and all the rivers of Judah shall flow with waters, and a fountain shall come forth of the house of the LORD, (NLT - A Fountain will burst forth from the Lord's Temple) and shall water the valley of Shittim.

Isaiah 45:1-3 Cyrus Anointing

- 1 **Thus saith the Lord to His anointed, to Cyrus, whose right hand I have holden, to subdue nations before him;** and I will loose the loins of kings, to open before him the two leaved gates; and the gates shall not be shut;
- 2 I will go before thee, and make the crooked places straight: I will break in pieces the gates of brass, and cut in sunder the bars of iron:
- 3 And I will give thee the treasures of darkness, and hidden riches of secret places, that thou mayest know that I, the Lord, which call thee by thy name, am the God of Israel.

Ezra 3:1-2, 6-8

1 And when the seventh month was come, and the children of Israel were in the cities, the people gathered themselves together as one man to Jerusalem. (one accord)

2 Then stood up Jeshua the son of Jozadak, and his brethren the priests, and Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, and his brethren, and builded the altar of the God of Israel, to offer burnt offerings thereon, as it is written in the law of Moses the man of God.

6 From the first day of the seventh month began they to offer burnt offerings unto the LORD. But the foundation of the temple of the LORD was not yet laid.

7 They gave money also unto the masons, and to the carpenters; and meat, and drink, and oil, unto them of Zidon, and to them of Tyre, to bring cedar trees from Lebanon to the sea of Joppa, according to the grant that they had of Cyrus king of Persia.

Daniel 7:13-14

13 I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him.

14 And **there was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom**, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: **his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away**, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed.

Isaiah 65:9

And **I will bring forth a seed out of Jacob, and out of Judah an inheritor of my mountains: (Mt Hebron)** and mine elect shall inherit it, and my servants shall dwell there.

Isaiah 60:5

5 Then thou shalt see, and flow together, and thine heart shall fear, and be enlarged; because **the abundance of the sea shall be converted unto thee**, the forces **of the Gentiles shall come unto thee**.
