Zechariah 4:10

For who hath despised the day of small things? for they shall rejoice, and shall see the plummet in the hand of Zerubbabel **with those seven** (Zechariah 3:9); **they are the eyes of the LORD, which run to and fro through the whole earth.**

❖ Revelation 5:5

I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns **and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.**

SOLOMON'S HOUSE

Haggai 2:2, 7-9

2 **Speak now to Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah,** and to Joshua the son of Josedech, the high priest, and to the residue of the people, saying,

7 I will shake all nations, and the desire of all nations shall come: and I will fill this house with glory, saith the LORD of hosts.

8 The silver is mine, and the gold is mine, saith the LORD of hosts.

9 **The glory of this latter house shall be greater than of the former,** saith the LORD of hosts: and in this place will I give peace, saith the LORD of hosts.

1 Kings 10:1-10

1 And **when the queen of Sheba heard of the fame of Solomon concerning the name of the LORD, she came to prove him with hard questions.**

2 And she came to Jerusalem with a very great train, with camels that bare spices, and very much gold, and precious stones: and when she was come to Solomon, she communed with him of all that was in her heart.

3 And **Solomon told her all her questions: there was not anything hid from the king, which he told her not.**

4 And **when the queen of Sheba had seen all Solomon's wisdom, and the house that he had built,**

5 And the meat of his table, and the sitting of his servants, and the attendance of his ministers, and their apparel, and his cupbearers, and **his ascent by which he went up unto the house of the LORD; there was no more spirit in her.**

6 And she said to the king, It was a true report that I heard in mine own land of thy acts and of thy wisdom.

7 Howbeit I believed not the words, until I came, and mine eyes had seen it: and, behold, the half was not told me: **thy wisdom and prosperity exceedeth the fame which I heard.**

8 **Happy are thy men, happy are these thy servants, which stand continually before thee, and that hear thy wisdom.**

SOLOMON'S WISDOM - THE 7 SPIRITS OF GOD

Isaiah 11:2

The Spirit of the Lord (Glory) shall rest upon him, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord.

❖ Proverbs 8: 8-14

8 All the words of my mouth are in righteousness; there is nothing froward or perverse in them.

9 They are all plain to him that understandeth, and **right to them that find knowledge.**

10 Receive my instruction, and not silver; **and knowledge rather than choice gold.**

11 For wisdom is better than rubies; and all the things that may be desired are not to be compared to it.

12 I wisdom dwell with prudence, and **find out knowledge of witty inventions.**

13 **The fear of the LORD** is to hate evil: pride, and arrogancy, and the evil way, and the froward mouth, do I hate.

14 **Counsel is mine, and sound wisdom: I am understanding; I have strength.**

❖ Proverbs 4:9

She shall give to thine head an ornament of grace: **a crown of glory shall she deliver to thee.**

THE HOUSE OF THE HARLOT (THE WORLD SYSTEM)

Proverbs 7:4-22, 26

4 Say unto wisdom, Thou art my sister; and call understanding thy kinswoman:

5 That they may keep thee from **the strange woman**, from the stranger which flattereth with her words.

6 For at the window of my house I looked through my casement,

7 And beheld among **the simple ones, I discerned among the youths, a young man void of understanding.**

8 Passing through the street near her corner; and **he went the way to her house,**

9 In the twilight, in the evening, in the black and dark night:

10 And, behold, **there met him a woman with the attire of an harlot, and subtle of heart.**

11 (She is loud and stubborn; her feet abide not in her house:

12 **Now is she without, now in the streets, and lieth in wait at every corner.)**

13 So she caught him, and kissed him, and with an impudent face said unto him,

14 I have peace offerings with me; this day have I payed my vows.

15 Therefore came I forth to meet thee, diligently to seek thy face, and I have found thee.

16 I have decked my bed with coverings of tapestry, with carved works, with fine linen of Egypt.

17 I have perfumed my bed with myrrh, aloes, and cinnamon.

18 **Come, let us take our fill of love until the morning:** let us solace ourselves with loves.

19 For the goodman is not at home, he is gone a long journey:

20 He hath taken a bag of money with him, and will come home at the day appointed.

21 **With her much fair speech she caused him to yield, with the flattering of her lips she forced him.**

22 He goeth after her straightway, as an ox goeth to the slaughter, or as a fool to the correction of the stocks;

26 **For she hath cast down many wounded: yea, many strong men have been slain by her.**

WISDOM'S HOUSE

Proverbs 8:1-3, 6, 11-12, 15-21

- 1 **Doth not wisdom cry? and understanding put forth her voice?**
- 2 **She standeth in the top of high places, by the way in the places of the paths.**
- 3 She crieth at the gates, at the entry of the city, at the coming in at the doors.

- 6 **Hear; for I will speak of excellent things; and the opening of my lips shall be right things.**

- 11 Wisdom is better than rubies; and all the things that may be desired are not to be compared to it.
- 12 I wisdom dwell with prudence, and **find out knowledge of witty inventions.**

- 15 **By me kings reign, and princes decree justice.**
- 16 **By me princes rule, and nobles, even all the judges of the earth.**
- 17 I love them that love me; and those that seek me early shall find me.
- 18 **Riches and honour are with me; yea, durable riches and righteousness.**
- 19 My fruit is better than gold, yea, than fine gold; and my revenue than choice silver.
- 20 **I lead in the way of righteousness, in the midst of the paths of judgment (right decisions)**
- 21 **That I may cause those that love me to inherit substance; and I will fill their treasures.**

WISDOM IN CREATION

Proverbs 8:22-31

- 22 **The LORD possessed me in the beginning of his way, before his works of old.**
- 23 I was set up from everlasting, from the beginning, or ever the earth was.
- 24 When there were no depths, I was brought forth; when there were no fountains abounding with water.
- 25 Before the mountains were settled, before the hills was I brought forth:
- 26 While as yet he had not made the earth, nor the fields, nor the highest part of the dust of the world.
- 27 **When he prepared the heavens, I was there:** when he set a compass upon the face of the depth:
- 28 When he established the clouds above: when he strengthened the fountains of the deep:
- 29 When he gave to the sea his decree, that the waters should not pass his commandment: **when he appointed the foundations of the earth:**
- 30 **Then I was by him, as one brought up with him: and I was daily his delight, rejoicing always before him;**
- 31 **Rejoicing in the habitable part of his earth; and my delights were with the sons of men.**

WISDOMS HOUSE - THE 7 PILLARS OF WISDOM

Proverbs 9:1-6

Wisdom hath builded her house, she hath hewn out her seven pillars:

❖ James 3:17

The wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy.

❖ The 7 Pillars of Wisdom - Righteousness, Peace, Gentleness, Humility, Mercy, Equality, Truth

THE TWO HOUSES

Proverbs 9:1-6

- 1 Wisdom hath builded her house, she hath hewn out her seven pillars:
- 2 She hath killed her beasts; she hath mingled her wine; she hath also furnished her table.
- 3 She hath sent forth her maidens: she crieth upon the highest places of the city,
- 4 Whoso is simple, let him turn in hither: as for him that wanteth understanding, she saith to him,
- 5 Come, eat of my bread, and drink of the wine which I have mingled.

❖ Proverbs 8:1-2

- 1 Doth not wisdom cry? and understanding put forth her voice?
- 2 She standeth in the top of high places, by the way in the places of the paths.

Proverbs 9:13-18

- 13 A foolish woman is clamorous: she is simple, and knoweth nothing.
- 14 For she sitteth at the door of her house, on a seat in the high places of the city,
- 15 To call passengers who go right on their ways:
- 16 Whoso is simple, let him turn in hither: and as for him that wanteth understanding, she saith to him,
- 17 Stolen waters are sweet, and bread eaten in secret is pleasant.
- 18 But he knoweth not that the dead are there; and that her guests are in the depths of hell.

WISDOM'S HOUSE NEW TESTAMENT

Ephesians 1:20-21

- 20 Which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set him at his own right hand in the heavenly places,
- 21 Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come:

❖ Ephesians 2:1-6

- 1 And you hath he quickened, who were dead in trespasses and sins;
- 2 Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience:
- 6 And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus:

Revelation 4:5

Out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunderings and voices: and there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.

Proverbs 4:18-19

The path of the just is as the shining light, that shineth more and more unto the perfect day. The way of the wicked is as darkness: they know not at what they stumble.
