

## THE GOLDEN LAMPSTAND - THE FINAL LIGHT

Revelation 1:10-13, 20

10 I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and heard behind me a great voice, as of a trumpet,

12 And I turned to see the voice that spake with me. And being turned, I saw seven golden candlesticks;

13 And in the midst of the seven candlesticks one like unto the Son of man, clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girt about the paps with a golden girdle.

20 The mystery of the seven stars which thou sawest in my right hand, and the seven golden candlesticks. The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches: and the seven candlesticks which thou sawest are the seven churches.

❖ Revelation 2:1

Unto the angel of the church of Ephesus write; These things saith he that holdeth the seven stars in his right hand, who walketh in the midst of the seven golden candlesticks;

Revelation 3:7-11

7 To the angel (messenger) of the church in Philadelphia write; These things saith he that is holy, he that is true, he that hath the key of David (The House of David), he that openeth, and no man shutteth; and shutteth, and no man openeth;

8 I know thy works: behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it: for thou hast a little strength, and hast kept my word, and hast not denied my name.

10 Because thou hast kept the word of my patience, I also will keep thee from the hour of temptation, which shall come upon all the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth.

11 Behold, I come quickly: hold that fast which thou hast, that no man take thy crown.

❖ Isaiah 22:22

The key of the house of David will I lay upon his shoulder; so he shall open, and none shall shut; and he shall shut, and none shall open.

### JOHN SEES 7 LAMPS - 7 SPIRITS OF GOD AS THINGS TO COME

Revelation 4:1-2, 5

1 After this I looked, and, behold, a door was opened in heaven: and the first voice which I heard was as it were of a trumpet talking with me; which said, Come up hither, and I will shew thee things which must be hereafter.

2 Immediately I was in the spirit: and, behold, a throne was set in heaven, and one sat on the throne.

3 And he that sat was to look upon like a jasper and a sardine stone: and there was a rainbow round about the throne, in sight like unto an emerald.

4 And round about the throne were four and twenty seats: and upon the seats I saw four and twenty elders sitting, clothed in white raiment; and they had on their heads crowns of gold.

5 Out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunderings and voices: and there were seven lamps of fire (torches) burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.

- ❖ Revelation 1:4-5 Greetings from The Trinity - Holy Spirit addressed as 7 Spirits of God
  - 4 John to the seven churches which are in Asia: Grace be unto you, and peace, **from him which is, and which was, and which is to come**; and **from the seven Spirits which are before his throne**; (AMP - The Sevenfold Holy Spirit)
  - 5 **And from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness**, and the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth...

#### JOHN NOW SEES THE 7 LAMPS AS 7 HORNS AND 7 EYES - SENT FORTH INTO ALL THE EARTH

Revelation 5:1, 5-6

1 **I saw in the right hand of him that sat on the throne a book** written within and on the backside, sealed with seven seals.

5 And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: **behold, the Lion of the tribe of Juda, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book**, and to loose the seven seals thereof.

6 I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, **stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.**

- ❖ Revelation 3:1  
Unto the angel of the church in Sardis write; **These things saith he that hath the seven Spirits of God**, and the seven stars...
- ❖ Acts 2:32-33  
32 This Jesus hath God raised up, whereof we all are witnesses.  
33 **Therefore being by the right hand of God exalted**, and **having received of the Father the promise of the Holy Ghost**, he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear.

Zechariah 4:2, 6, 9-10

2 The Angel said unto me, What seest thou? And I said, **I have looked, and behold a candlestick all of gold, with a bowl upon the top of it, and his seven lamps thereon, and seven pipes to the seven lamps, which are upon the top thereof:**

6 Then he answered and spake unto me, saying, **This is the word of the Lord unto Zerubbabel**, saying, Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit, saith the Lord of hosts.

7 Who art thou, O great mountain? before Zerubbabel thou shalt become a plain: and **he shall bring forth the headstone** thereof with shoutings, crying, Grace, grace unto it.

9 **The hands of Zerubbabel have laid the foundation of this house; his hands shall also finish it**; and thou shalt know that the LORD of hosts hath sent me unto you.

10 For who hath despised the day of small things? for they shall rejoice, and **shall see the plummet in the hand of Zerubbabel with those seven; they are the eyes of the Lord, which run to and fro through the whole earth.**

- ❖ Zechariah 3:3-9  
For **behold the stone that I have laid before Joshua; upon one stone shall be seven eyes**: behold, I will engrave the graving thereof, saith the LORD of hosts, and **I will remove the iniquity of that land in one day.**

Haggai 2:2-3, 6-9

2 **Speak now to Zerubbabel** the son of Shealtiel, **governor of Judah, and to Joshua** the son of Josedech, **the high priest**, and to the residue of the people, saying,

3 **Who is left among you that saw this house in her first glory? and how do ye see it now? is it not in your eyes in comparison of it as nothing?**

6 For thus saith the LORD of hosts; Yet once, it is a little while, and I will shake the heavens, and the earth, and the sea, and the dry land;

7 And **I will shake all nations, and the desire (treasures) of all nations shall come: and I will fill this house with glory, saith the LORD of hosts.**

8 **The silver is mine, and the gold is mine, saith the LORD of hosts.**

9 **The glory of this latter house shall be greater than of the former**, saith the LORD of hosts: **and in this place will I give peace (prosperity), saith the LORD of hosts.**

❖ Ezra 3:1-2, 10-13

1 And when the seventh month was come, and the children of Israel were in the cities, the people gathered themselves together as one man to Jerusalem.

2 **Then stood up Joshua** the son of Josedech, and his brethren the priests, **and Zerubbabel** the son of Shealtiel, and his brethren, and builded the altar of the God of Israel...

10 And **when the builders laid the foundation of the temple of the LORD**, they set the priests in their apparel with trumpets, and the Levites the sons of Asaph with cymbals, to praise the LORD, after the ordinance of David king of Israel.

11 They sang together by course in praising and giving thanks unto the LORD; because he is good, for his mercy endureth for ever toward Israel. All the people shouted with a great shout, when they praised the LORD, **because the foundation of the house of the LORD was laid.**

12 **But many of the priests and Levites and chief of the fathers, who were ancient men, that had seen the first house, when the foundation of this house was laid before their eyes, wept with a loud voice;** and many shouted aloud for joy:

13 **So that the people could not discern the noise of the shout of joy from the noise of the weeping of the people:** for the people shouted with a loud shout, and the noise was heard afar off.

Revelation 5:7-12

7 And **he came and took the book out of the right hand of him that sat upon the throne.**

8 And when he had taken the book, the four beasts and four and twenty elders fell down before the Lamb, having every one of them harps, and **golden vials (bowls) full of odours, (incense) which are the prayers of saints.**

9 **And they sung a new song**, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation;

10 And **hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth.**

11 And I beheld, and I heard the voice of many angels round about the throne and the beasts and the elders: and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands;

12 Saying with a loud voice, **Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing.**
