

THE GREAT TRIBULATION - THE FINAL DAYS

THE HARVEST OF THE GREAT TRIBULATION

Revelation 14:14-16

14 And I looked, and behold a white cloud, and upon the cloud one sat like unto the Son of man, having on his head a golden crown, and in his hand a sharp sickle.

15 And another angel came out of the temple, crying with a loud voice to him that sat on the cloud, Thrust in thy sickle, and reap: for the time is come for thee to reap; for the harvest of the earth is ripe.

16 And he that sat on the cloud thrust in his sickle on the earth; and the earth was reaped.

❖ Revelation 7:9,13- 15

9 After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands;

13 And one of the elders answered, saying unto me, What are these which are arrayed in white robes? and whence came they?

14 I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me, These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

15 Therefore are they before the throne of God, and serve him day and night in his temple: and he that sitteth on the throne shall dwell among them.

BATTLE OF ARMAGEDDON AND THE GREAT WINEPRESS OF WRATH

Revelation 14:17-20

17 And another angel came out of the temple which is in heaven, he also having a sharp sickle.

18 And another angel came out from the altar, which had power over fire; and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth; for her grapes are fully ripe.

19 And the angel thrust in his sickle into the earth, and gathered the vine of the earth, and cast it into the great winepress of the wrath of God.

20 And the winepress was trodden without the city, and blood came out of the winepress, even unto the horse bridles, by the space of a thousand and six hundred furlongs. (200 miles)

Revelation 19:11-12, 14-15, 21

11 And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war.

12 His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on his head were many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself.

14 And the armies which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.

15 Out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

21 And the remnant were slain with the sword of him that sat upon the horse, which sword proceeded out of his mouth: and all the fowls were filled with their flesh.

❖ **Antichrist and False Prophet Cast Alive into the Lake of Fire**

Revelation 19:19-20

19 And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army.

20 And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.

❖ **Devil Bound for 1000 Years in a Bottomless Pit**

Revelation 20:1-2 (Continuance from Chapter 19)

1 And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand.

2 he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years,

THE ENDTIME REAPER ANGELS

Matthew 13:36-42, 49-50

36 Then Jesus sent the multitude away, and went into the house: and his disciples came unto him, saying, Declare unto us the parable of the tares of the field.

37 He answered and said unto them, He that soweth the good seed is the Son of man;

38 The field is the world; the good seed are the children of the kingdom; but the tares are the children of the wicked one;

39 The enemy that sowed them is the devil; the harvest is the end of the world; and the reapers are the angels.

40 As therefore the tares are gathered and burned in the fire; so shall it be in the end of this world.

41 The Son of man shall send forth his angels, and they shall gather out of his kingdom all things that offend, and them which do iniquity;

42 And shall cast them into a furnace of fire: there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth.

49 So shall it be at the end of the world: the angels shall come forth, and sever the wicked from among the just,

50 And shall cast them into the furnace of fire: there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth.

❖ **Matthew 13:30 (Original Parable of Tares of the Field)**

Let both grow together until the harvest: and in the time of harvest I will say to the reapers, Gather ye together first the tares, and bind them in bundles to burn them: but gather the wheat into my barn.

UNRAVELING THE MYSTERIES OF MATTHEW 24

Matthew 24:14-16

14 And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.

15 When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place, (midway point of the 7 Year tribulation) whoso readeth, let him understand:

16 Then let them which be in Judaea flee into the mountains:

UNRAVELING THE MYSTERIES OF MATTHEW 24 (CONTINUED)

Matthew 24:21-22, 29-30, 37-41

21 **For then shall be great tribulation** (final 3 ½ years), such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, nor ever shall be.

22 And **except those days should be shortened, there should no flesh be saved** (AMP - no human being would endure or survive): but for the elect's sake those days shall be shortened.

29 **Immediately after the tribulation of those days** shall the sun be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, and the stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens shall be shaken:

30 And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and **they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.**

37 **But as the days of Noah were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.**

38 For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered into the ark,

39 And **knew not until the flood came, and took** (swept) **them all away; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.**

40 **Then shall two be in the field; the one shall be taken, and the other left.**

41 **Two women shall be grinding at the mill; the one shall be taken, and the other left.**

❖ Luke 17:26-30

26 And **as it was in the days of Noah**, so shall it be also in the days of the Son of man.

27 They did eat, they drank, they married wives, they were given in marriage, until the day that Noah entered into the ark, and **the flood came, and destroyed them all.**

28 **Likewise also as it was in the days of Lot**; they did eat, they drank, they bought, they sold, they planted, they builded;

29 But the same day that Lot went out of Sodom it rained fire and brimstone from heaven, and **destroyed them all.**

30 Even thus shall it be in the day when the Son of man is revealed.

❖ Luke 17:34-37 (AMP)

34 I tell you, in that night there will be two men in one bed; **one will be taken and the other will be left.**

35 There will be two women grinding together; **one will be taken and the other will be left.**

36 Two men will be in the field; **one will be taken and the other will be left.**

37 **Then they asked Him, Where, Lord?** He said to them, **Wherever the dead body is (carcass, corpse) there will the vultures be gathered together.** (or eagles ?)

❖ Matthew 24:28 (AMP)

Wherever there is a fallen body (a corpse), there the vultures will flock together. (or eagles ?)

A GLOBAL GATHERING OF THE SAINTS TO CHRIST AT JERUSALEM

Matthew 13:30 (Original Parable of the Tares)

Let both grow together until the harvest: and **in the time of harvest I will say to the reapers, Gather ye together first the tares**, and bind them in bundles to burn them: **but gather the wheat into my barn.**

Matthew 24:29-31

29 **Immediately after the tribulation of those days** shall the sun be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, and the stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens shall be shaken:
30 And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and **they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.**

31 And **he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.**

THE SAINTS WHO LIVED THROUGH THE GREAT TRIBULATION

Matthew 24:21-22 (AMP)

And if those days had not been shortened, no human being would endure and survive, but for the sake of the elect (God's chosen ones) those days will be shortened.

Revelation Ch. 7 & Ch. 14

The 144,000 that were sealed and commissioned are most likely still alive

Revelation 12:14 Israel Nourished for 3 ½ Year Duration of the Great Tribulation

To the woman were given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness, into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, from the face of the serpent.

Isaiah 27:12-13

12 And it shall come to pass in that day, that **the Lord shall beat off** (thresh out His grain) from the channel of the river unto the stream of Egypt, and **ye shall be gathered one by one, O ye children of Israel.**

13 And it shall come to pass in that day, that **the great trumpet shall be blown,** and **they shall come which were ready to perish** in the land of Assyria, and the outcasts in the land of Egypt, **and shall worship the Lord in the holy mount at Jerusalem.**

Zechariah 14:1-4, 16

1 Behold, the day of the Lord cometh, and thy spoil shall be divided in the midst of thee.

2 **For I will gather all nations against Jerusalem to battle;** and the city shall be taken, and the houses rifled, and the women ravished; and half of the city shall go forth into captivity, and the residue of the people shall not be cut off from the city.

3 **Then shall the Lord go forth, and fight against those nations,** as when he fought in the day of battle.

4 **His feet shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives, which is before Jerusalem on the east,** and the mount of Olives shall cleave in the midst thereof toward the east and toward the west, and there shall be a very great valley; and half of the mountain shall remove toward the north, and half of it toward the south.

16 **It shall come to pass, that every one that is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall even go up from year to year to worship the King,** the Lord of hosts, and to keep the feast of tabernacles.
